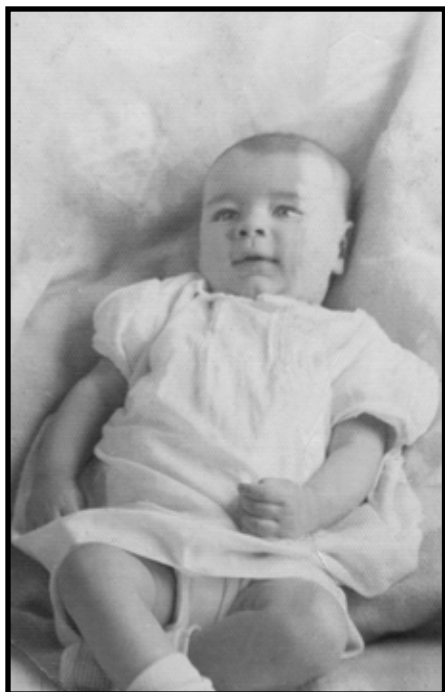
“On Eagles’ Wings”
