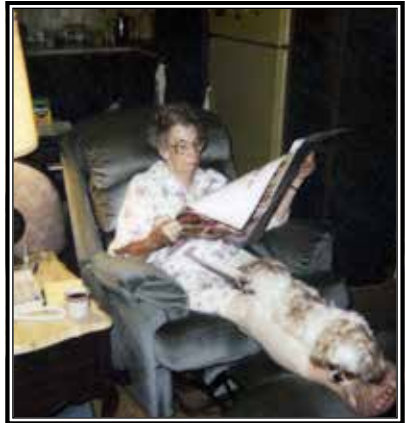
Eddie Lou raised many nieces and nephews from the Morris and Hall families. We called her Lou-Lou.
