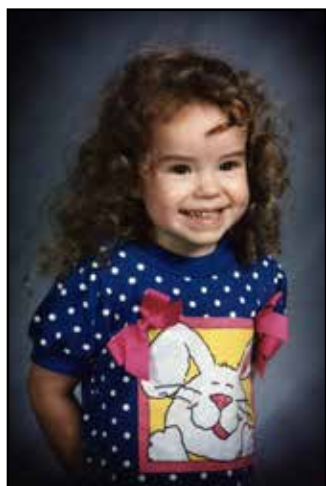
**Lesley Jayne Broome Hansen** passed away Tuesday, December 31, 2019, in Lumberton.
