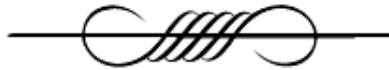

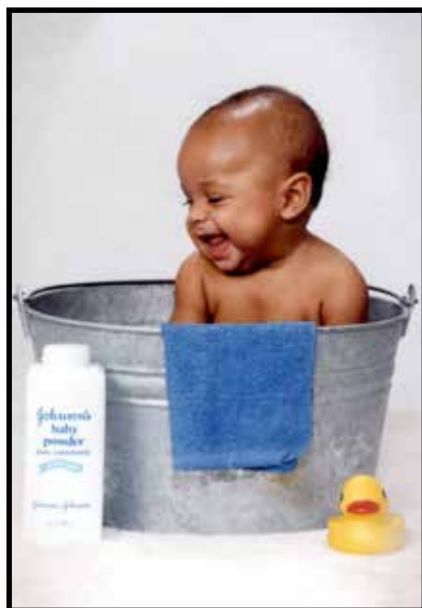
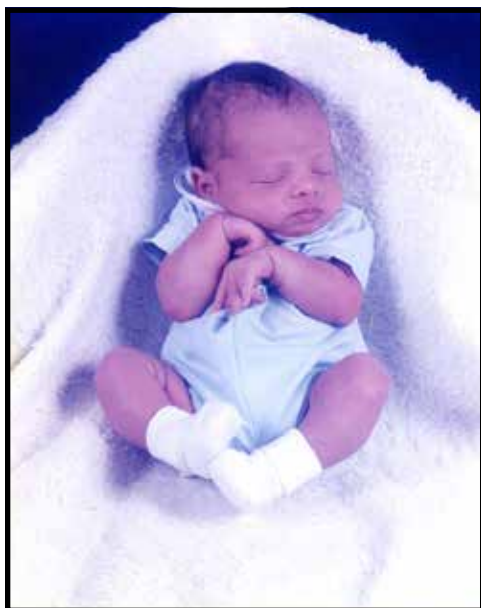

To All Parents

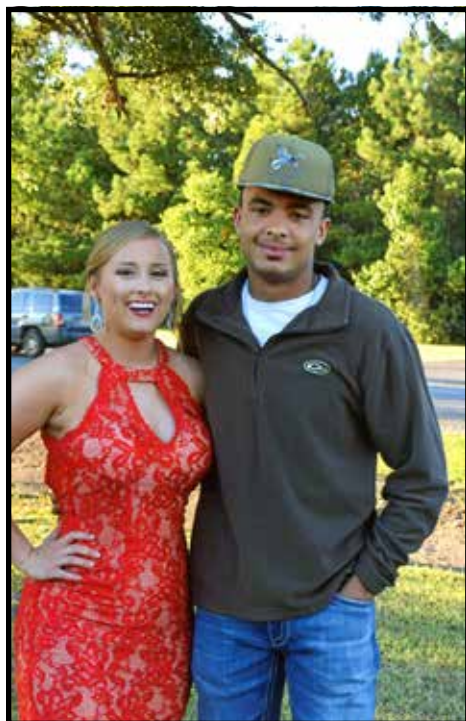
“I’ll lend you for a while a child of mine,” He said.
