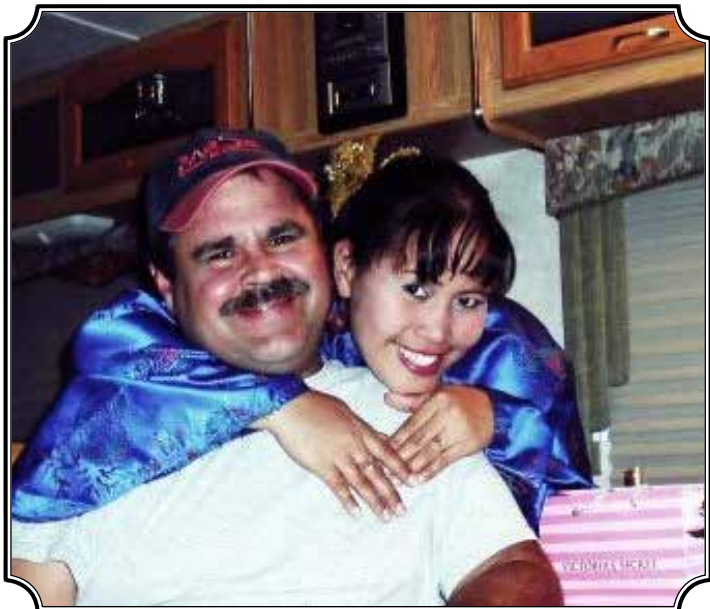
Richard is preceded in death by his father.











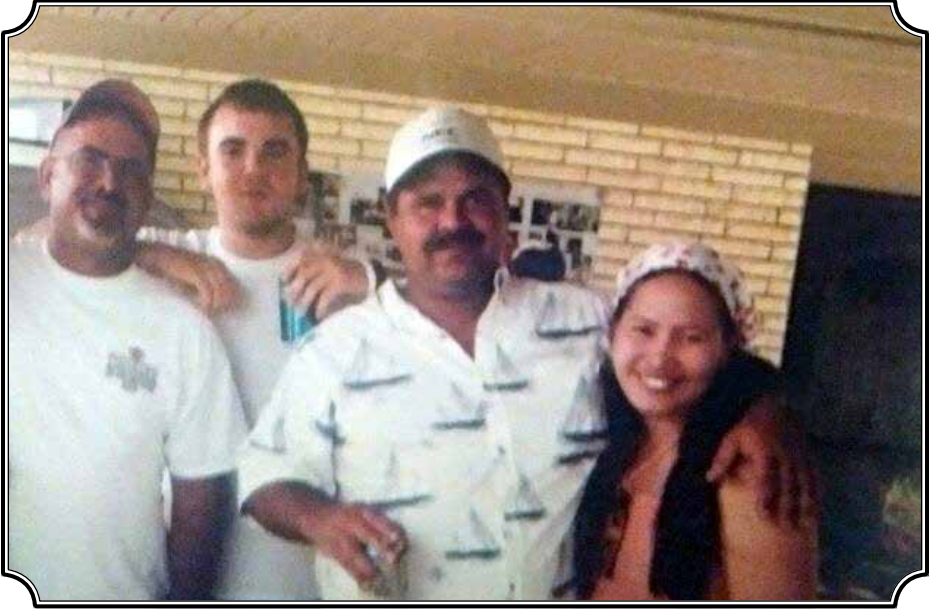














Gone Fishin'
