She is preceded in death by her husband, Thomas George Hebert and daughter, Theresa Hebert-Hennington.

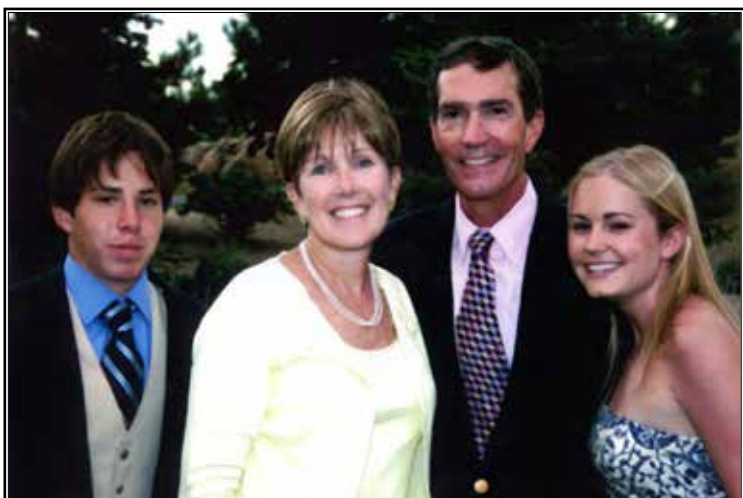
