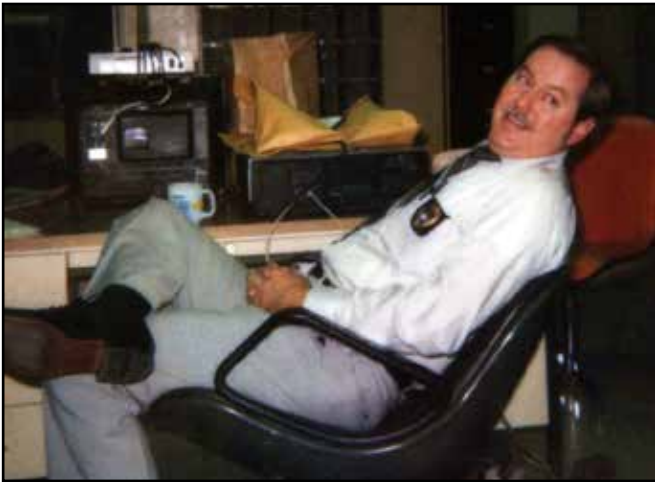

***Charles Morris Henderson***, 74, of Lumberton, went to be with his Heavenly Father, Tuesday, October 9, 2018, at Christus Hospital-St. Elizabeth, Beaumont. He was born on August 9, 1944, to Elizabeth Whitehead Henderson and Hubert Morris Henderson, in McAllen, and was a United States Army veteran. Charles retired in 1992 as a Captain with Beaumont Police Department after 26 years of service. After his retirement, he was a private investigator and process server. He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather who loved taking care of all of his girls, including his beautiful granddaughter.

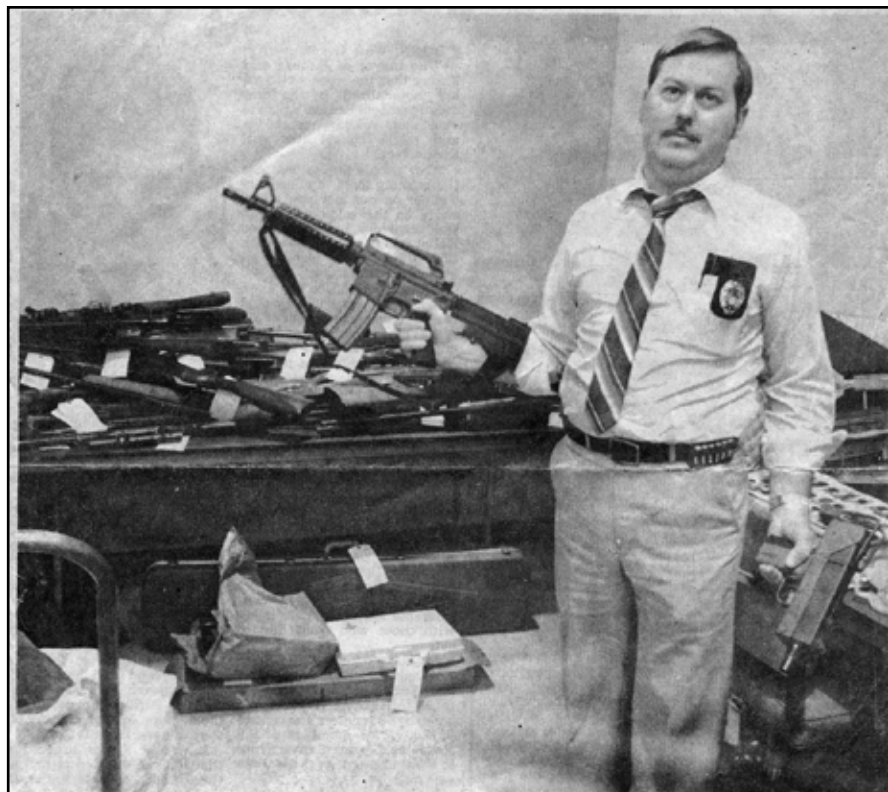
He is preceded in death by his parents and nephew, Kevin Wayne Johnson.

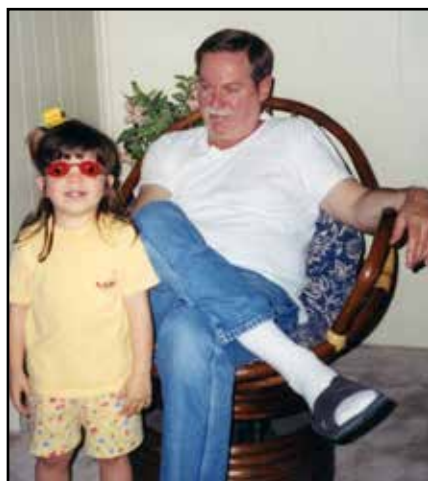
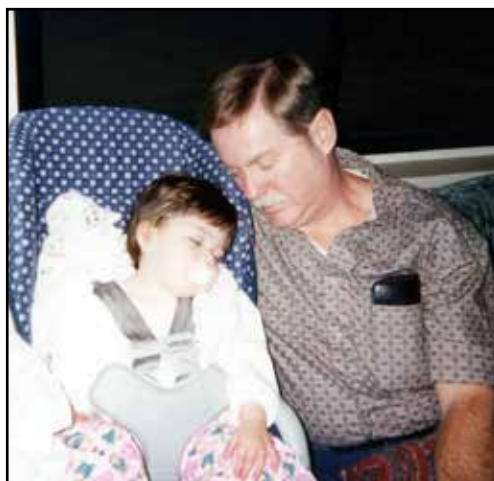
