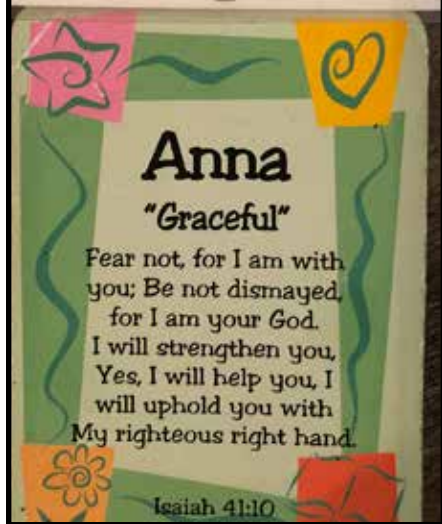
She will be greatly missed by all who loved her.
