“Aunt Doh Doh”, and was famous for her hot water cornbread and dumplings. She will be greatly missed by all.

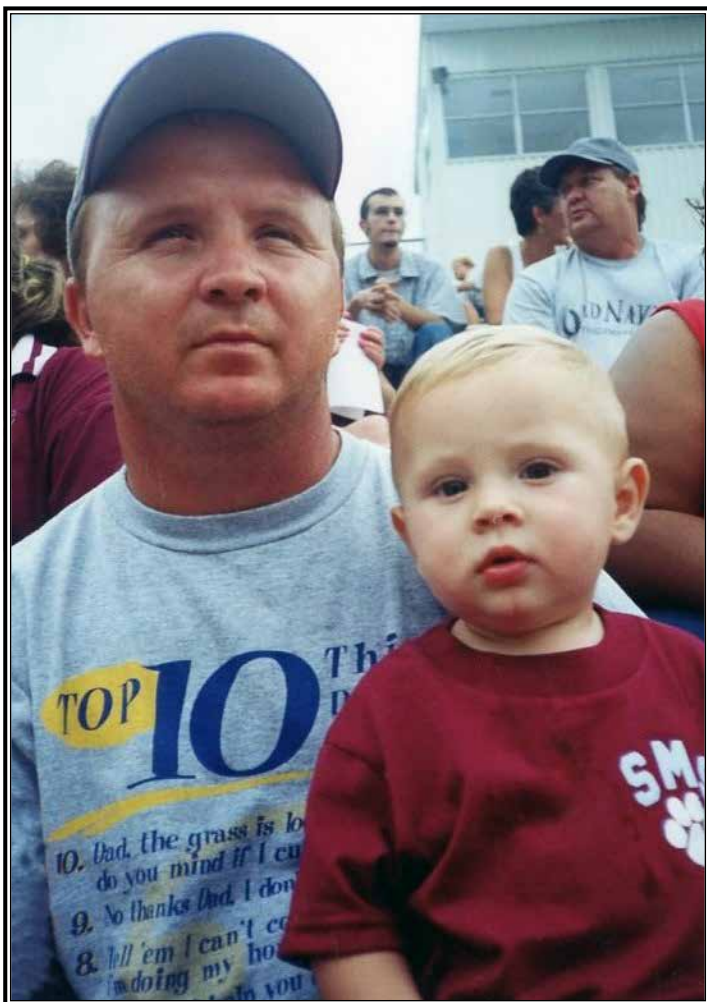
