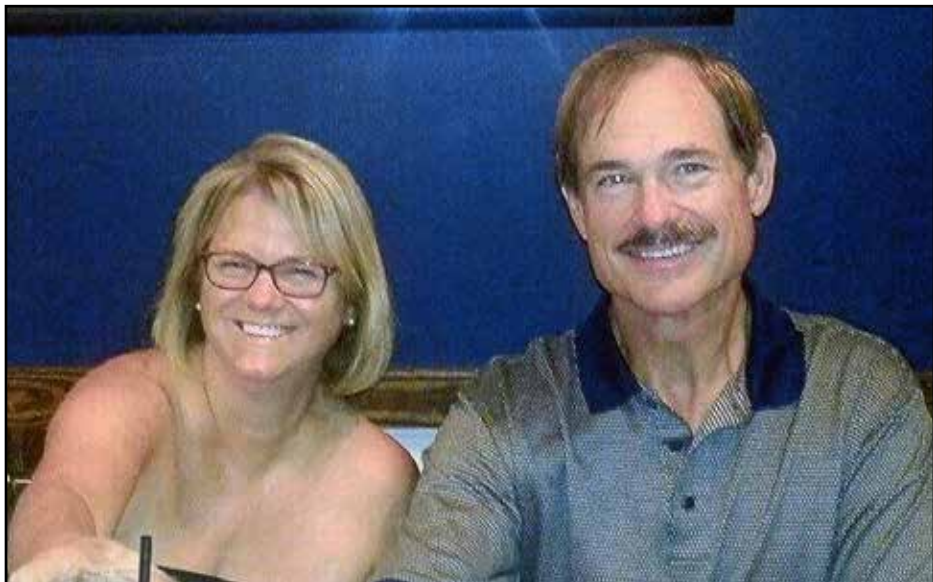

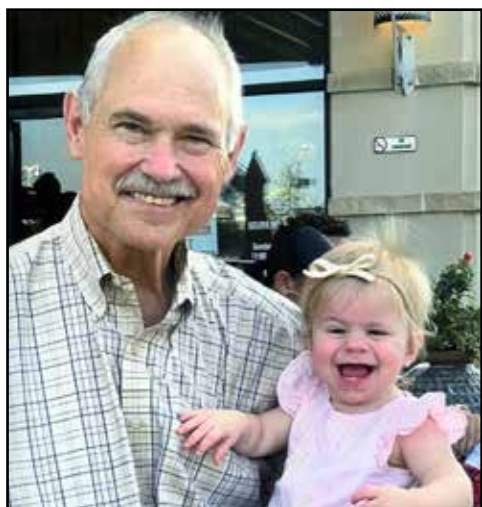

Dr. Huber is preceded in death by his parents; and brothers, Kyle and Chris Huber.







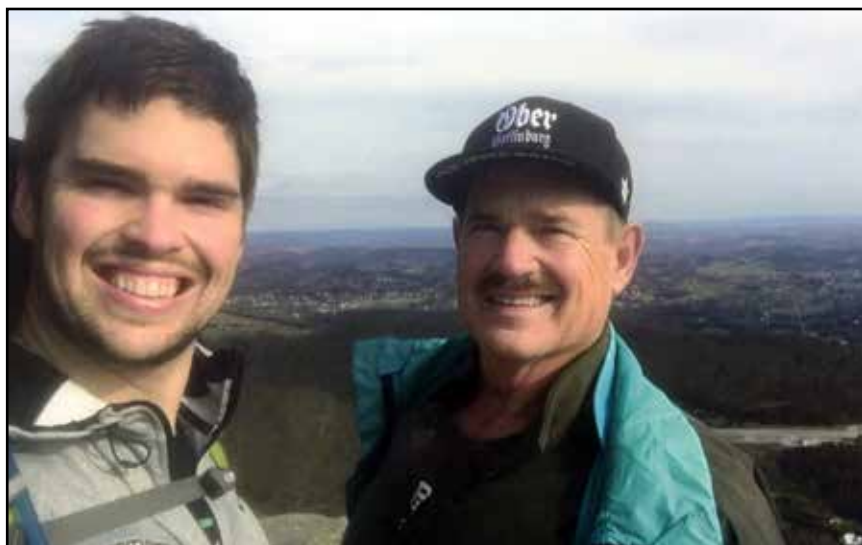
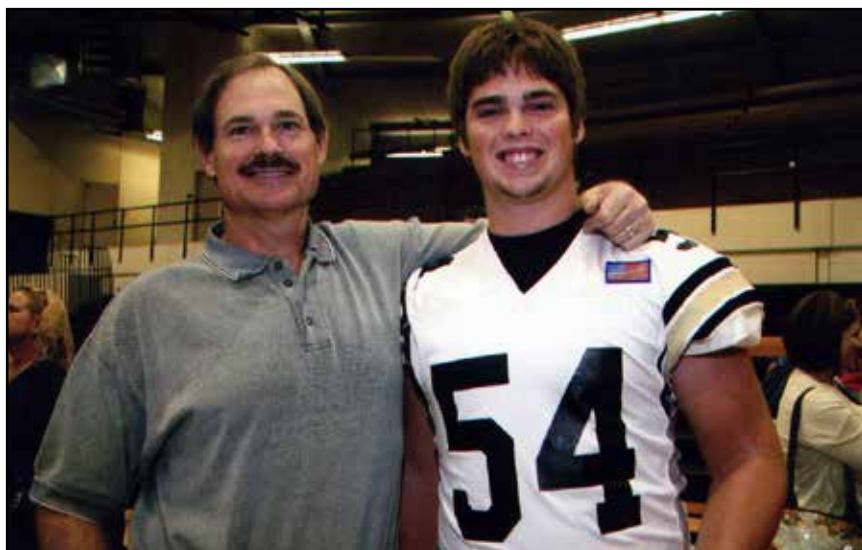


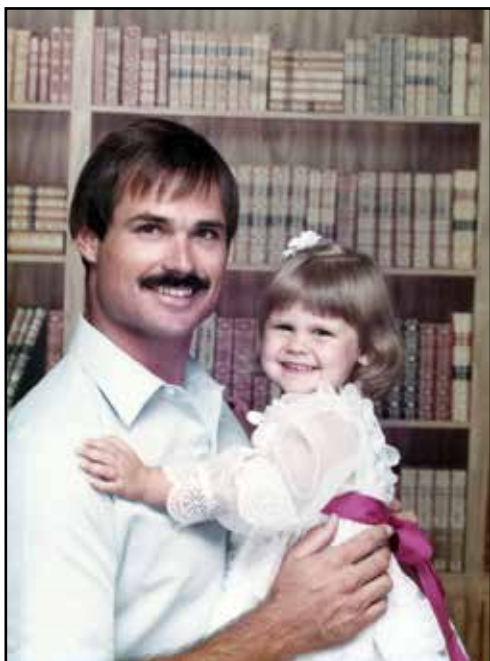
