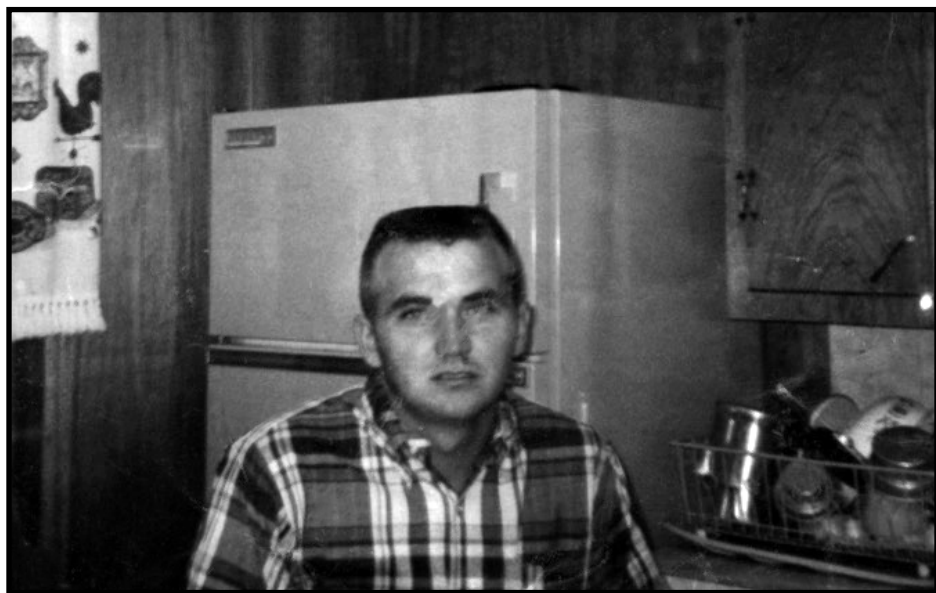
“Go Rest High on That Mountain”

He is preceded in death by his parents; wife, Janice “Toby” Lee Jagneaux; and brother, Joseph Lorenzo “JL” Jagneaux.





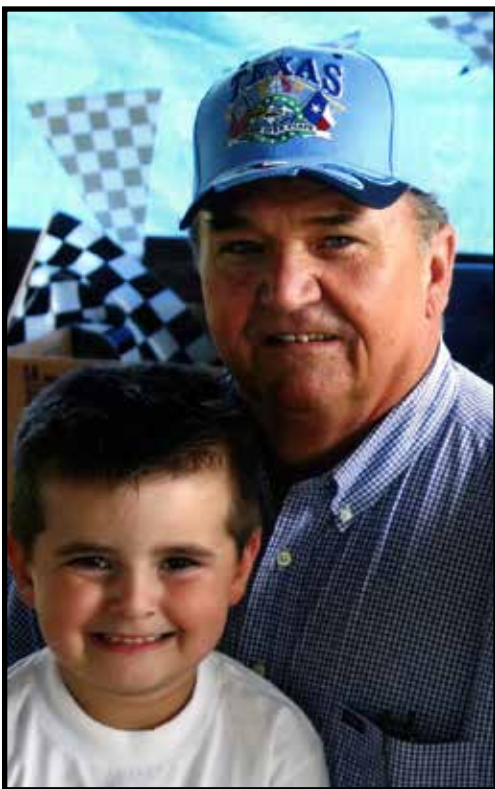












Dear Grandpa
