## **PRAYER OF COMMENDATION**



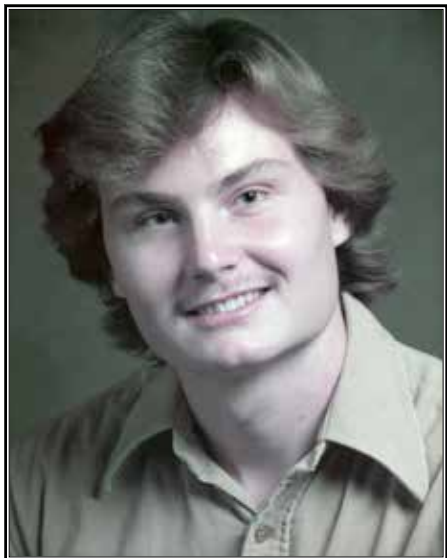
