She is preceded in death by her husband, Santos N. Hernandez.





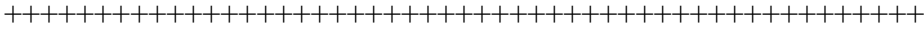




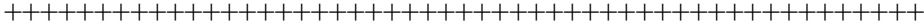
