She is preceded in death by her parents; husband, Hugh Kelley; and brother, Robert Charles DeLatte.

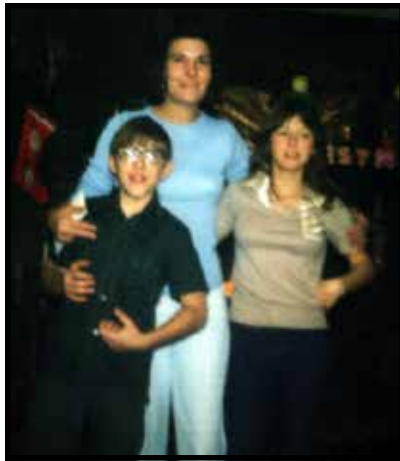
