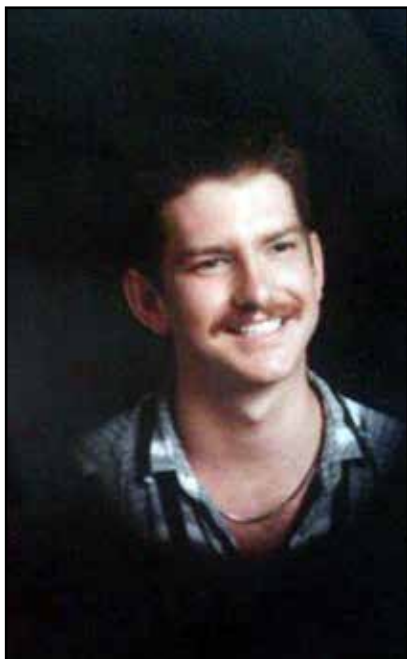
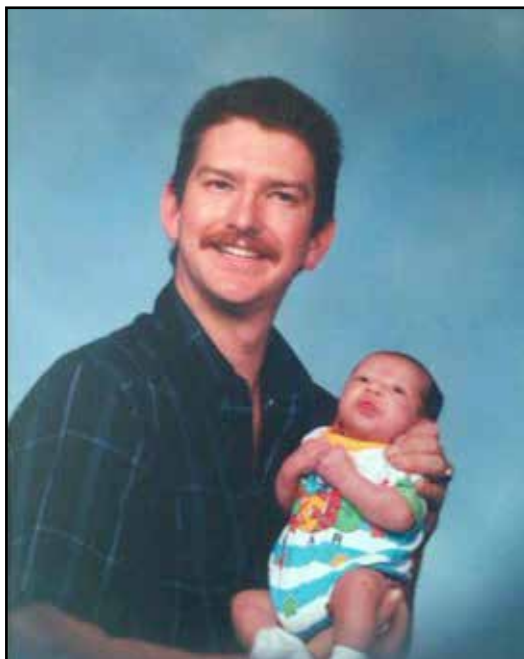
He is preceded in death by his parents and brother, James.



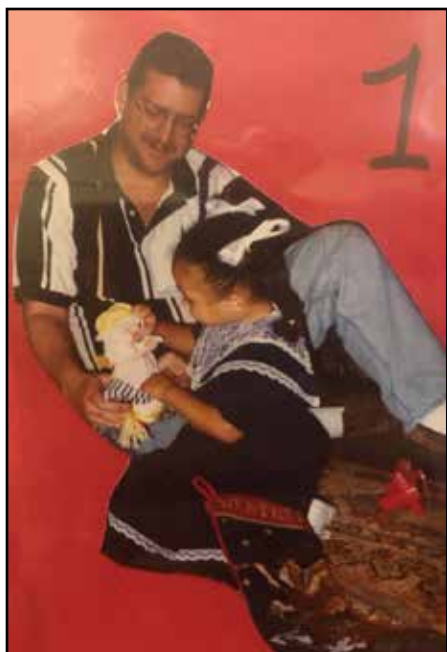


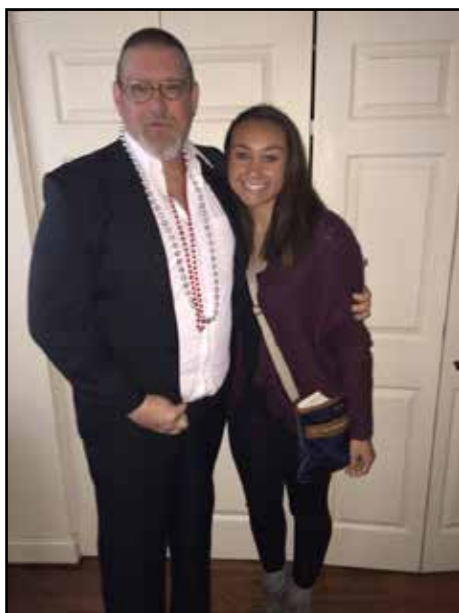












LIFE IS A CIRCLE
