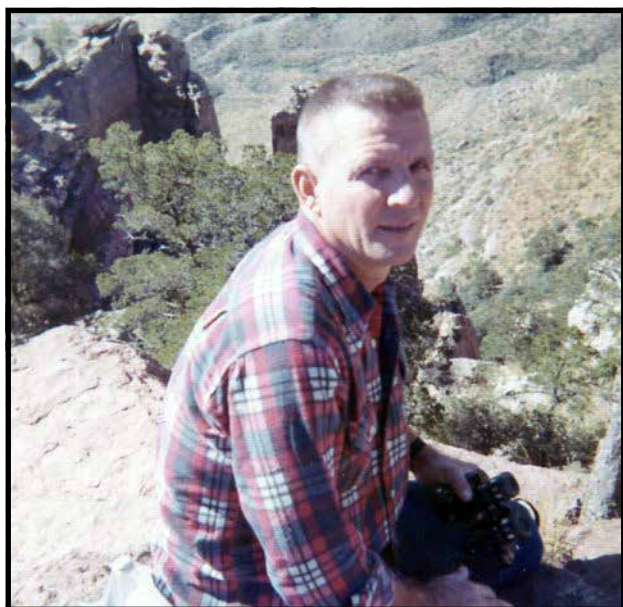
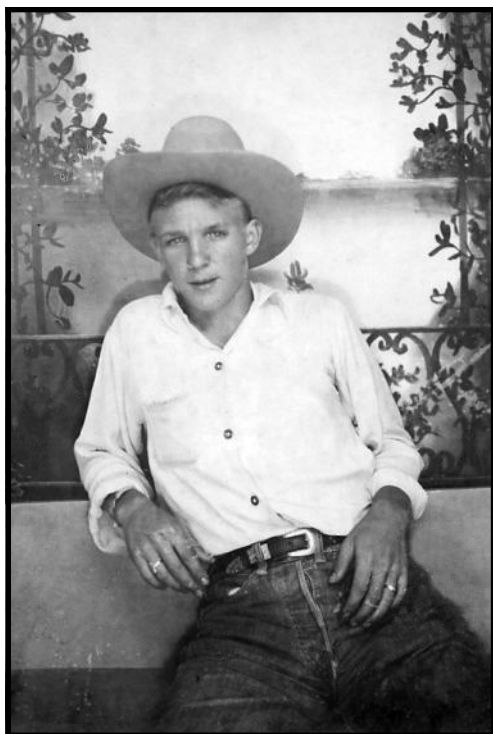

He is preceded in death by his parents, wife, and great-grandson, Trevor Lee Chesson, of Hamshire.





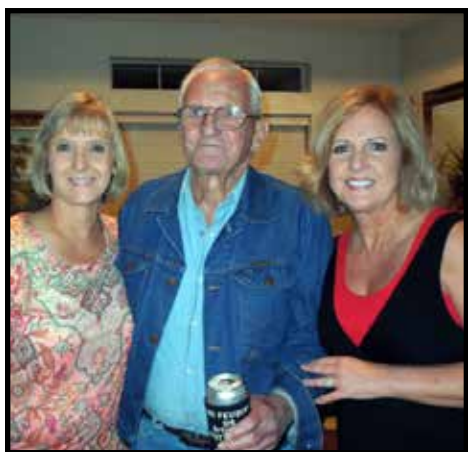
