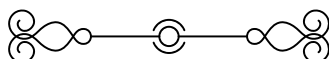

James was a member of First Baptist Church of Nederland. He enjoyed watching football and basketball as

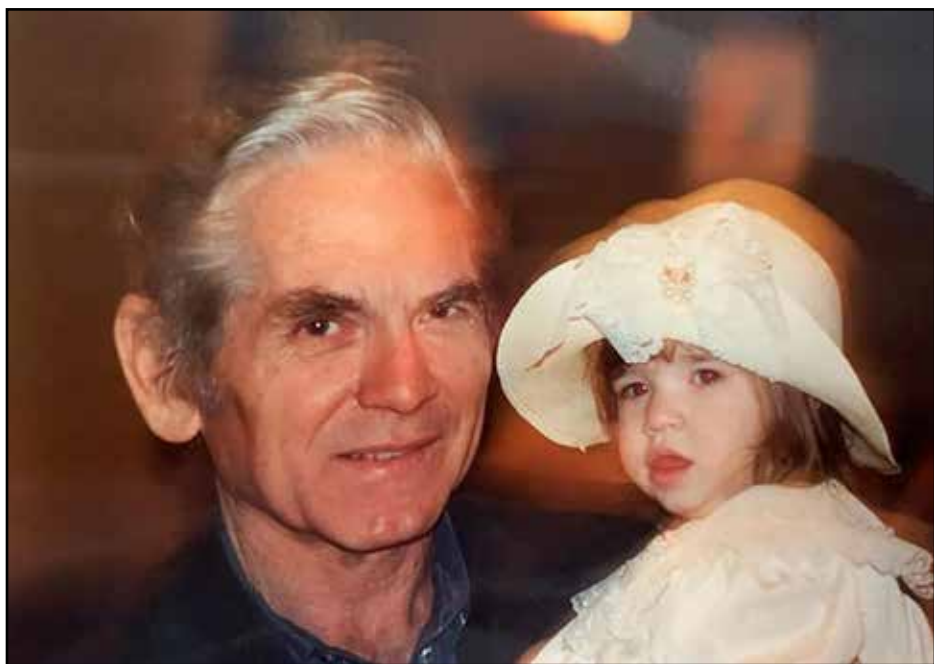
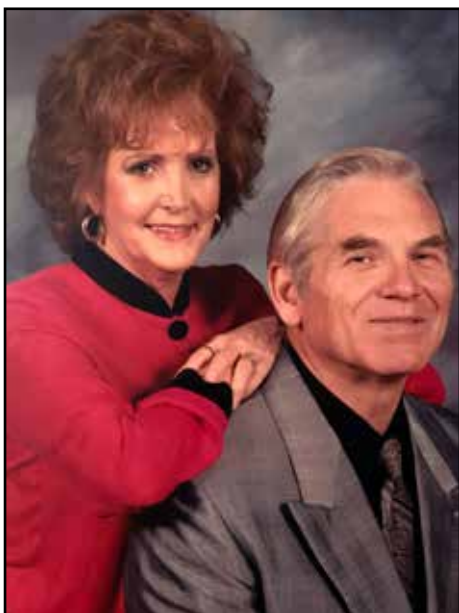
well as coaching both sports. He loved to spend time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren whom he adored greatly, as well as, traveling and visiting the lake cabin.

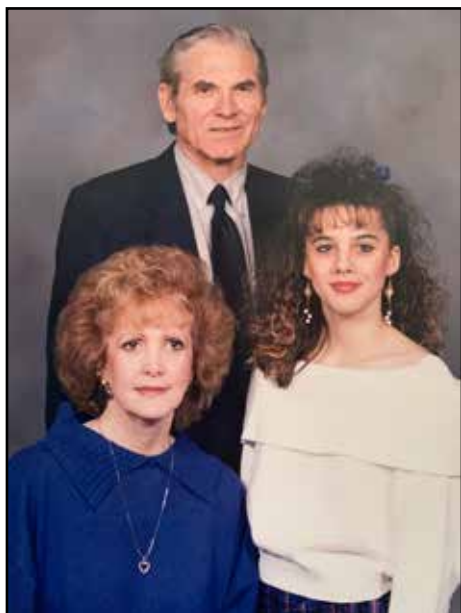

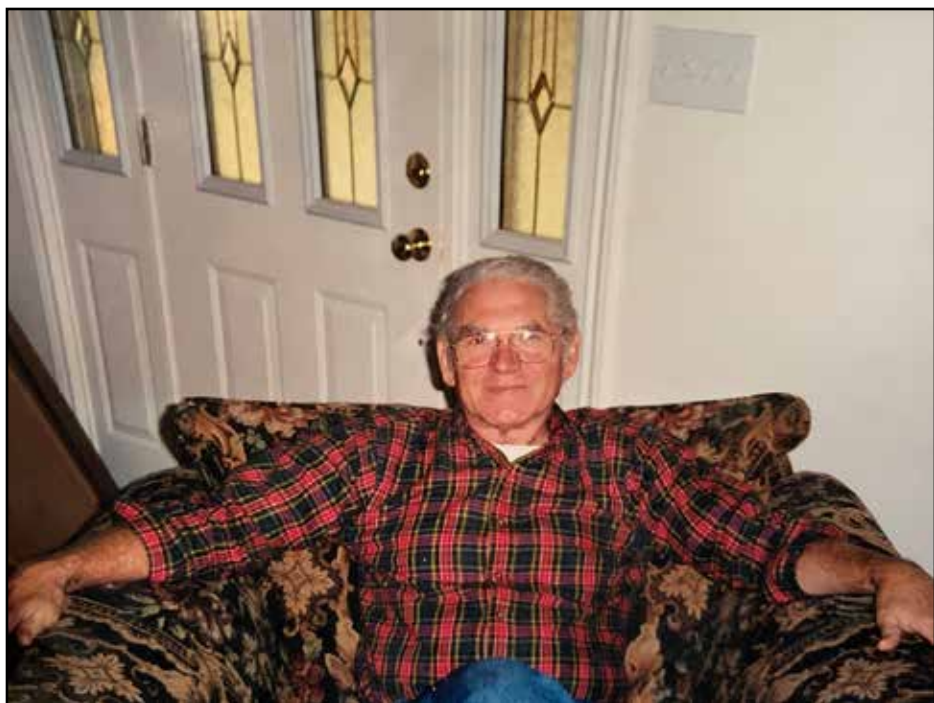
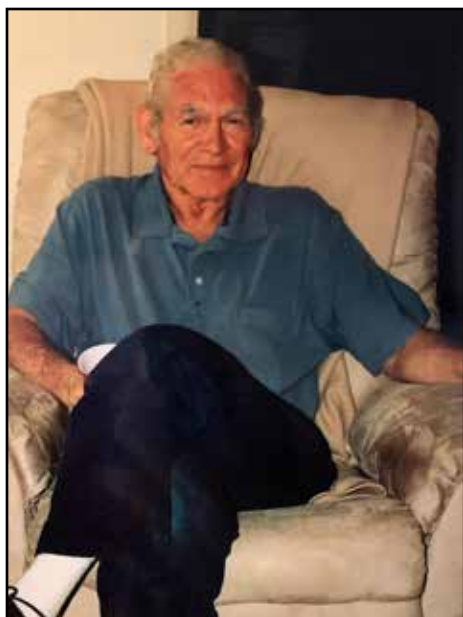
He is preceded in death by his parents, Della Mae and Darrell Kuykendall; and granddaughter, Katrina Fontenot.

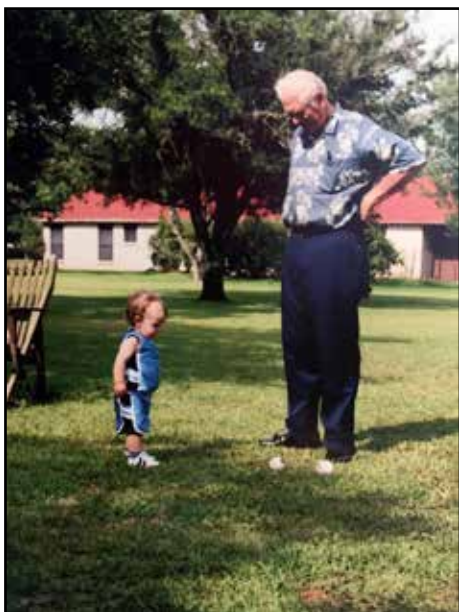




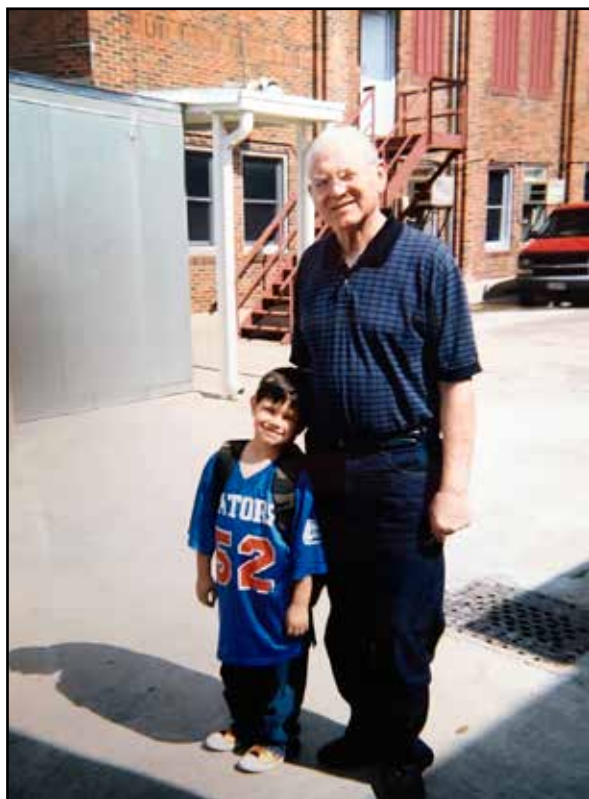
