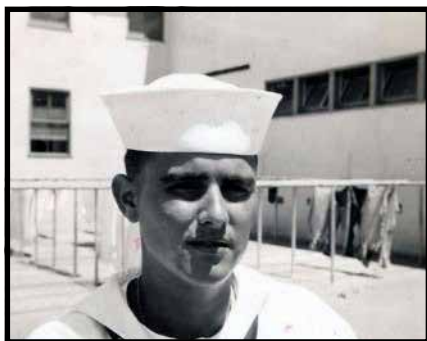


## Douglas "Doug" LeMaire,
