

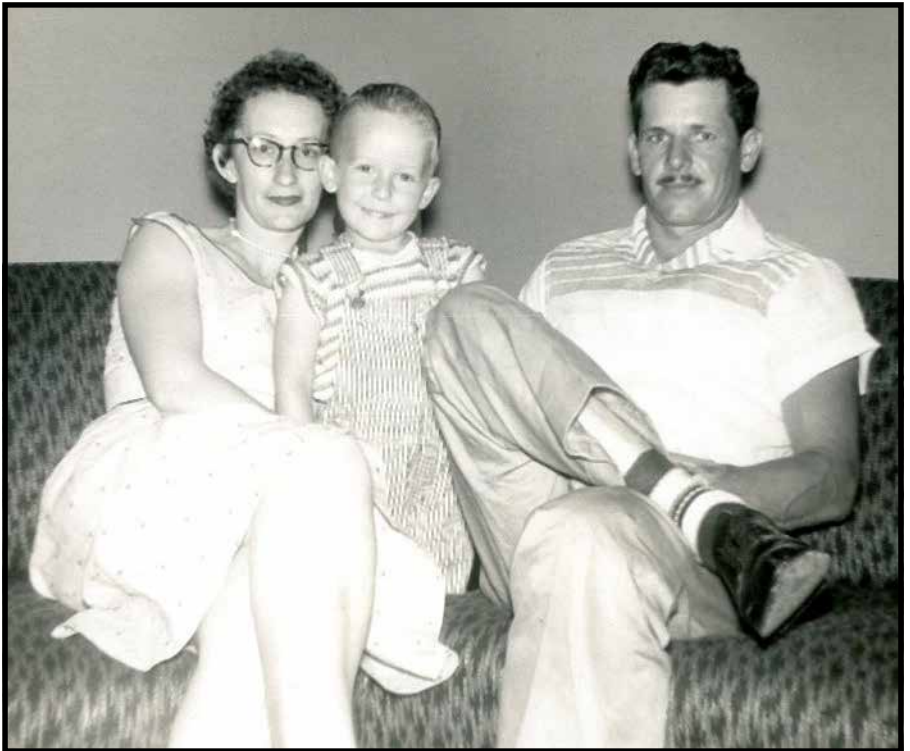
“You Should Be Here”
