Pop was a faithful member of Freedom Christian Fellowship Church. He was a retired Lineman for

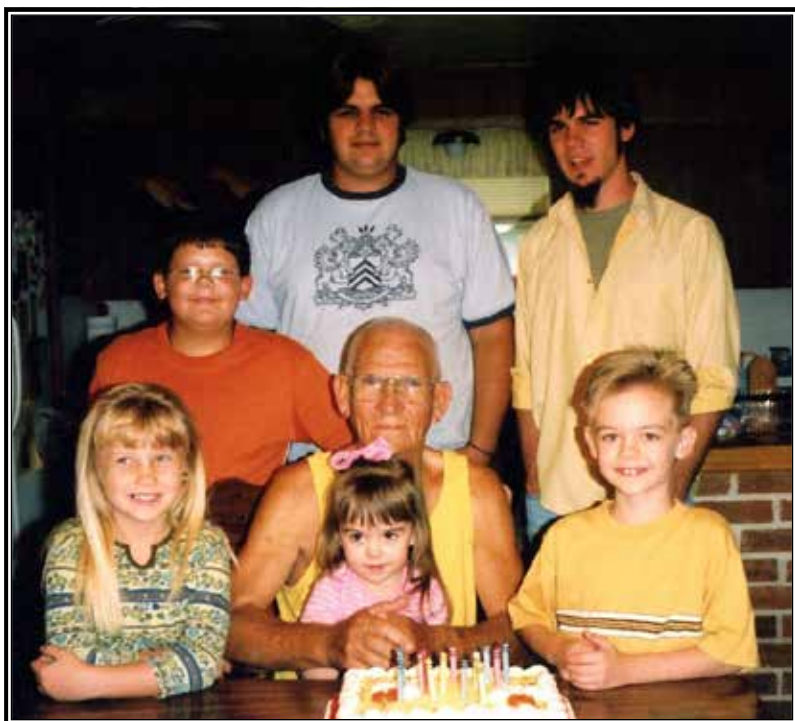
Southwestern Bell and a United States Army Veteran, having served in the Korean War. Pop loved fishing and maintaining a garden.
