Bunnie is preceded in death by her parents; and brother, Richard O’Hare.





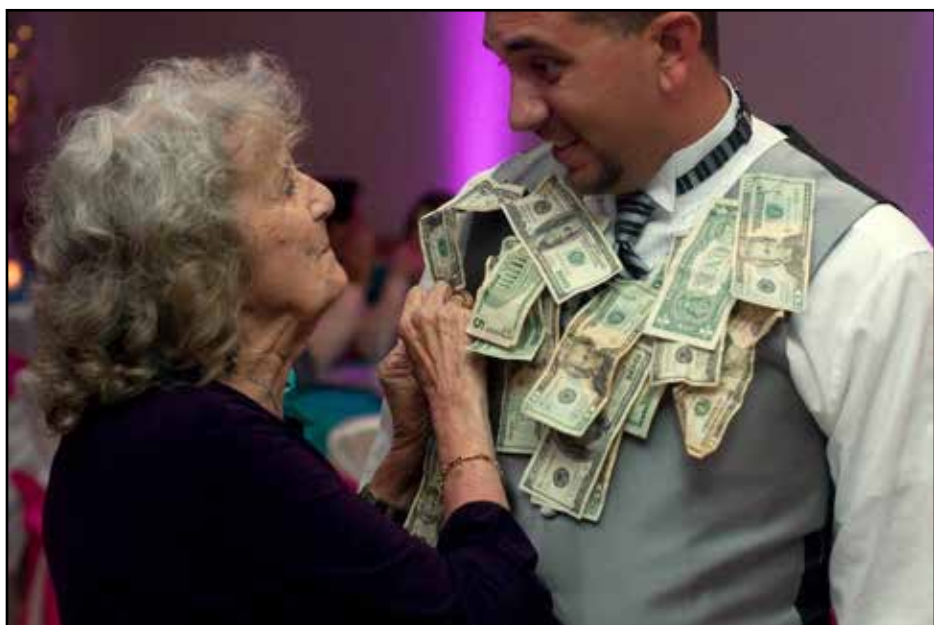
