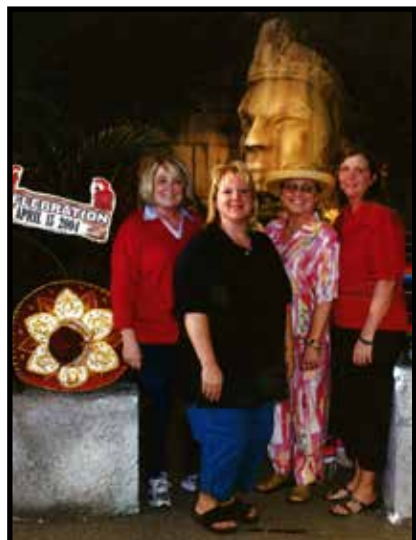

On Angel's Wings

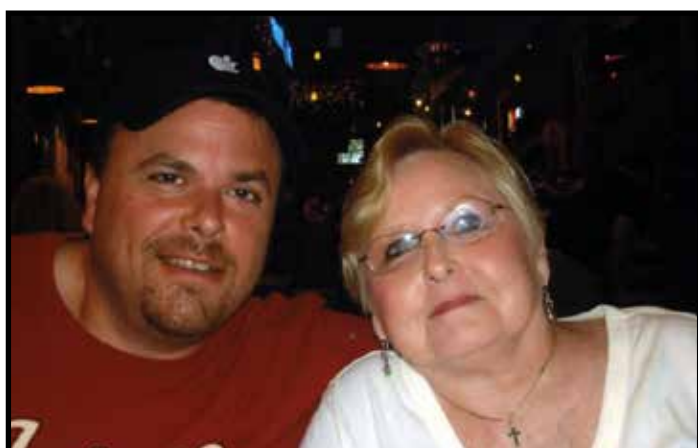
