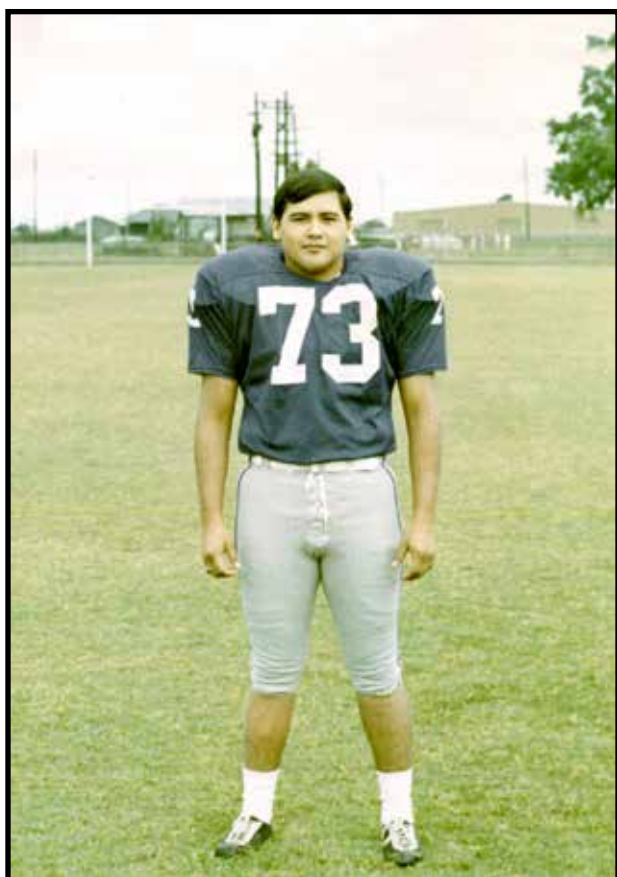

Johnny is preceded in death by his father, John V. Martinez, Sr.



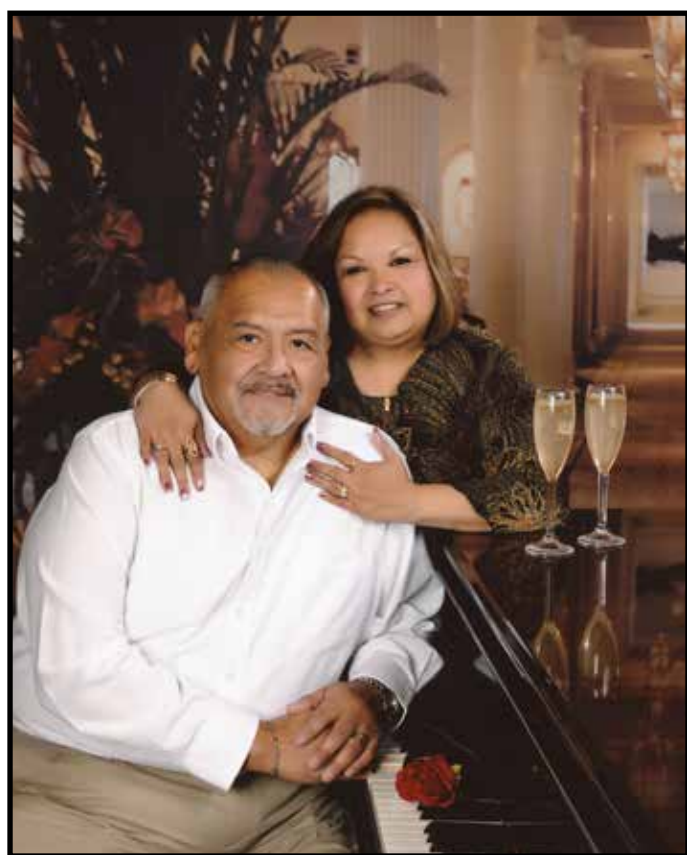
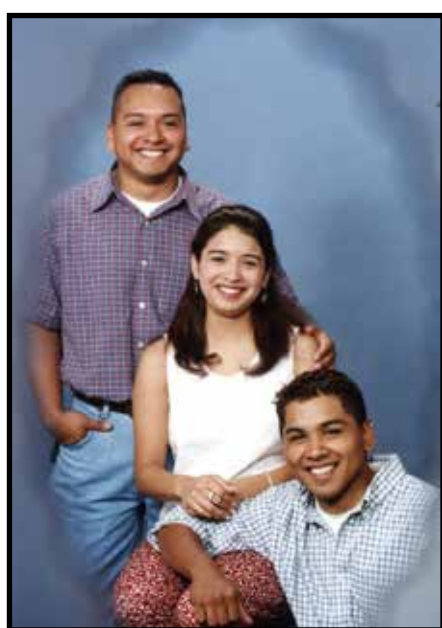
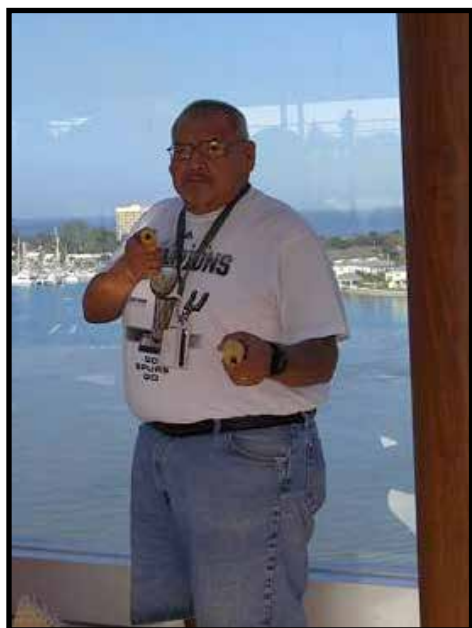
