Aunt Virgie was an active member at St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church in Nederland and loved her family.

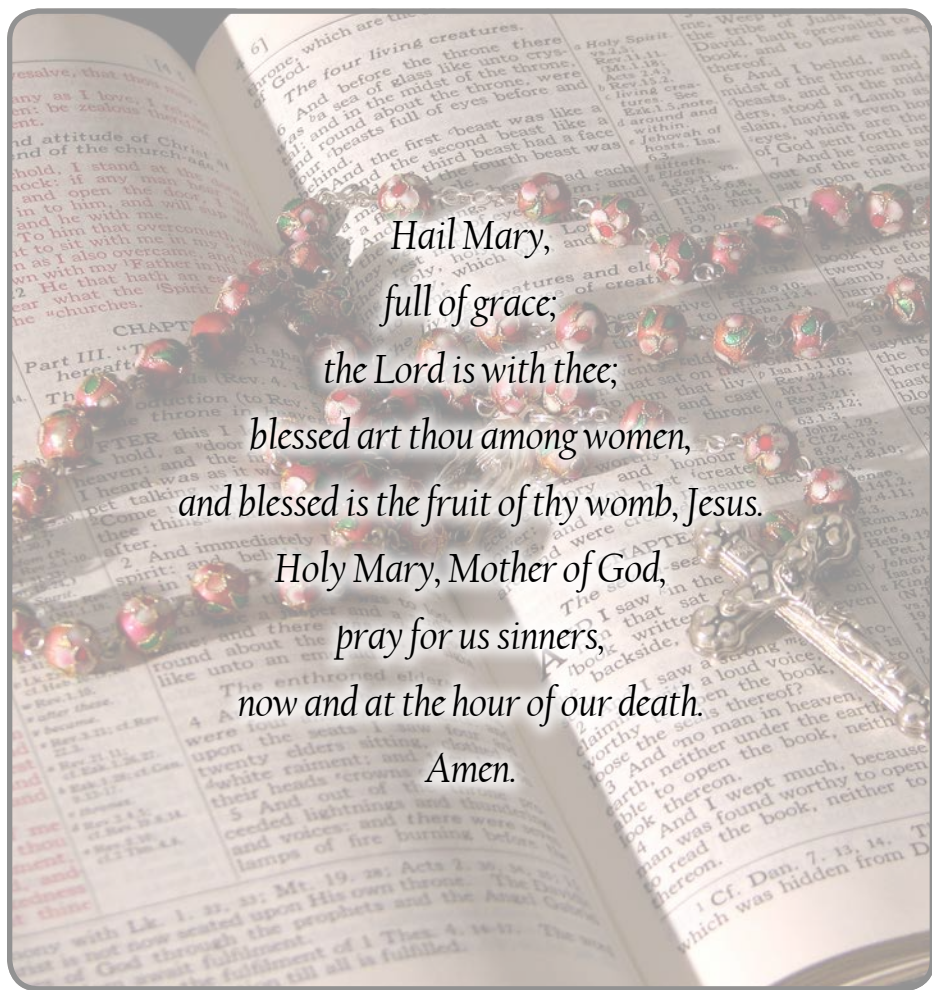
