Carroll L. "Butch" McClain, 74, of Beaumont, passed away on Easter Sunday, April 16, 2017, at 6:22 a.m., at Christus Hospital- St. Elizabeth in Beaumont, Texas, after a long struggle with Parkinson's.

retired from Exxon Mobil in Beaumont as a supervisor in operations. He was beloved by his fellow operators as "two cents".

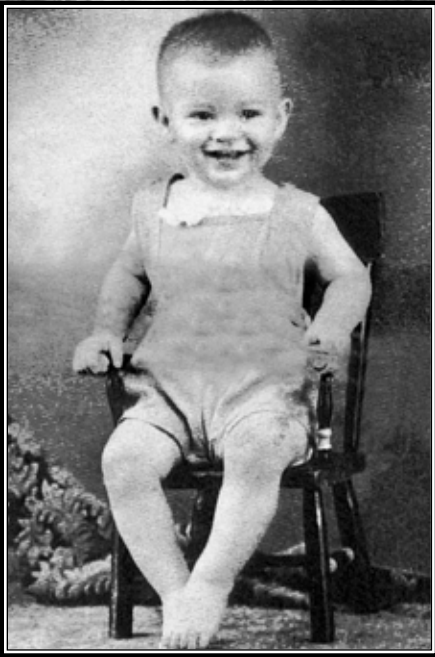
He was an active and faithful Christian man. He was involved in bus ministry, Sunday school ministry, head usher, and board member of The Apostolic Church in Beaumont.
