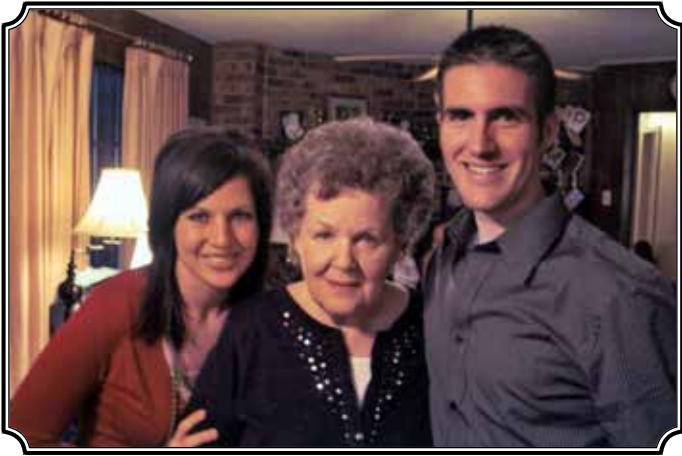

She was preceded in death by her husband, James Lester McCoy; and sister, Margaret Henn.



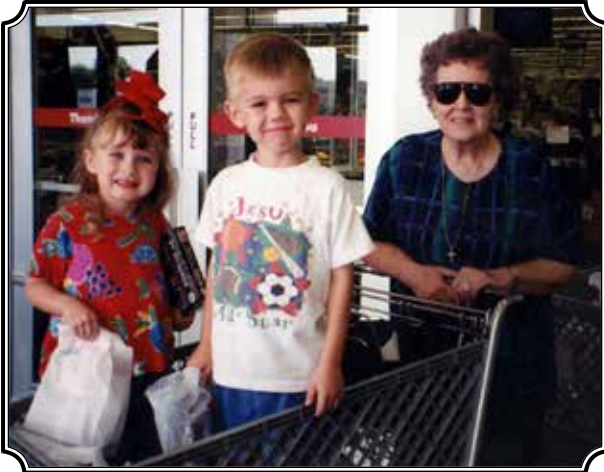








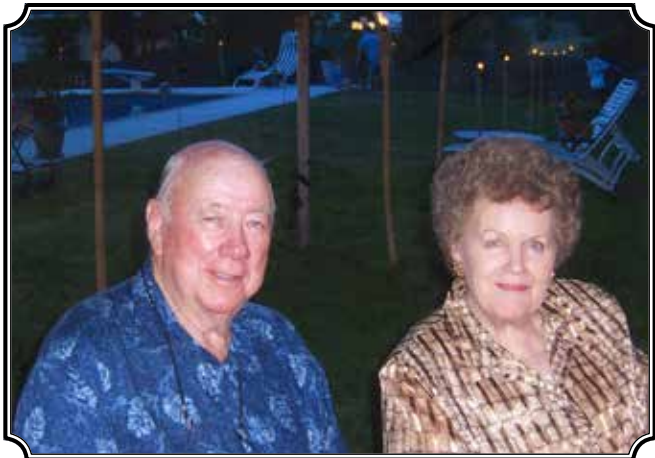
