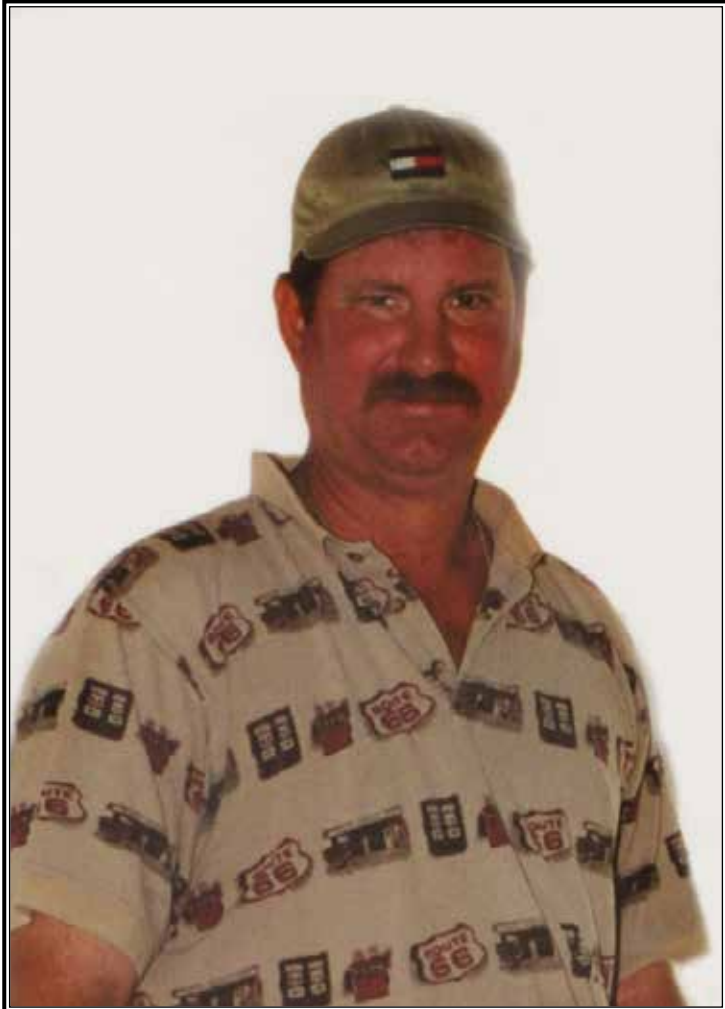

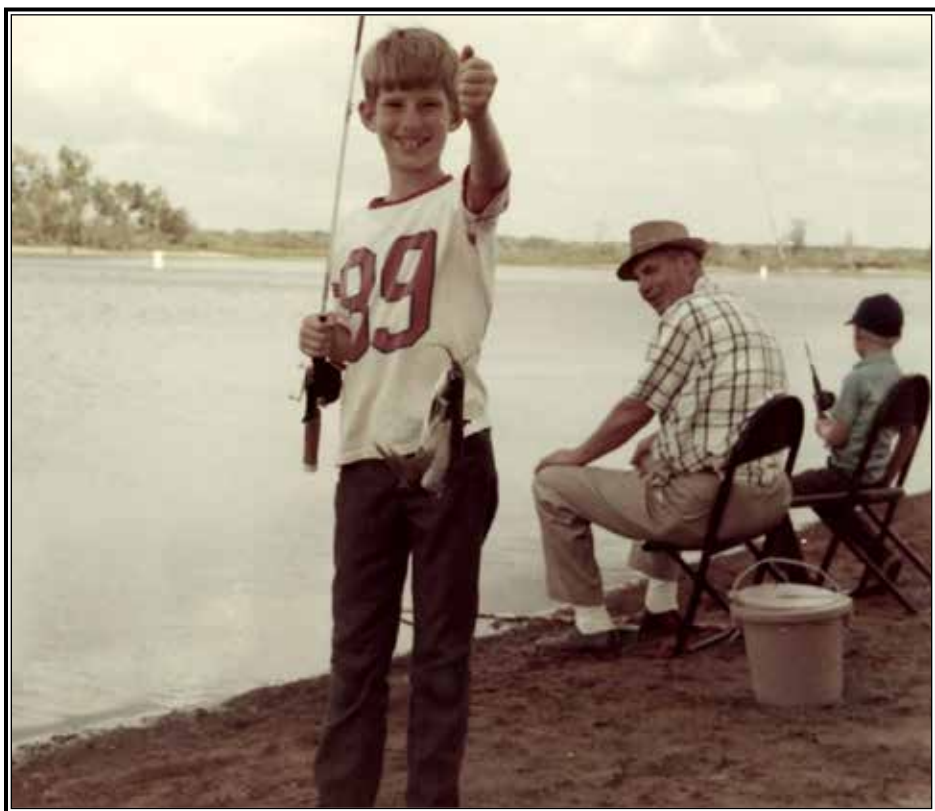
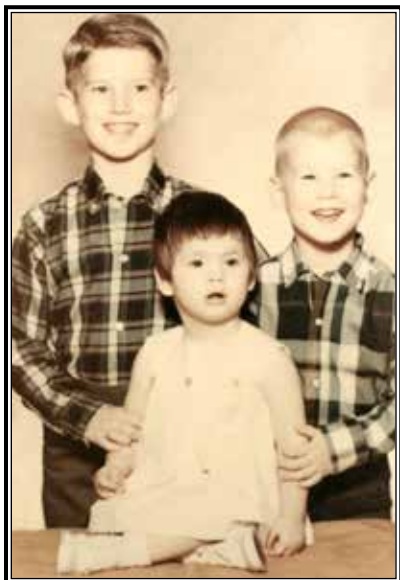
Terrence Michael "Terry" McGovern, Jr., 58, of Beaumont, passed away at his home on Sunday July 1, 2018.

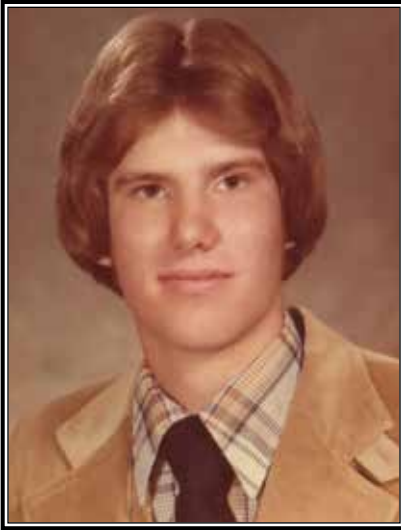

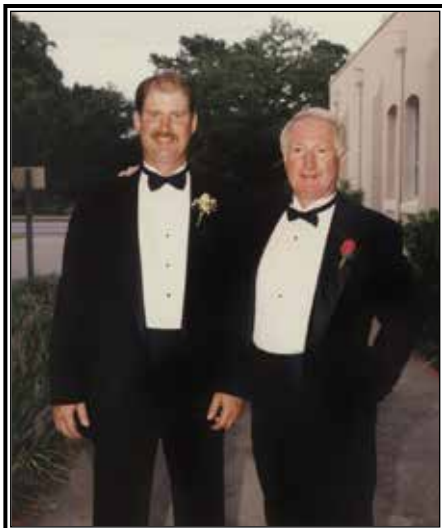
Terry enjoyed music, cooking, fishing, golf, and hunting. He loved camping and anything that kept him outdoors. He had a big heart and was always willing to

share a story or lend a helping hand to anyone in need.

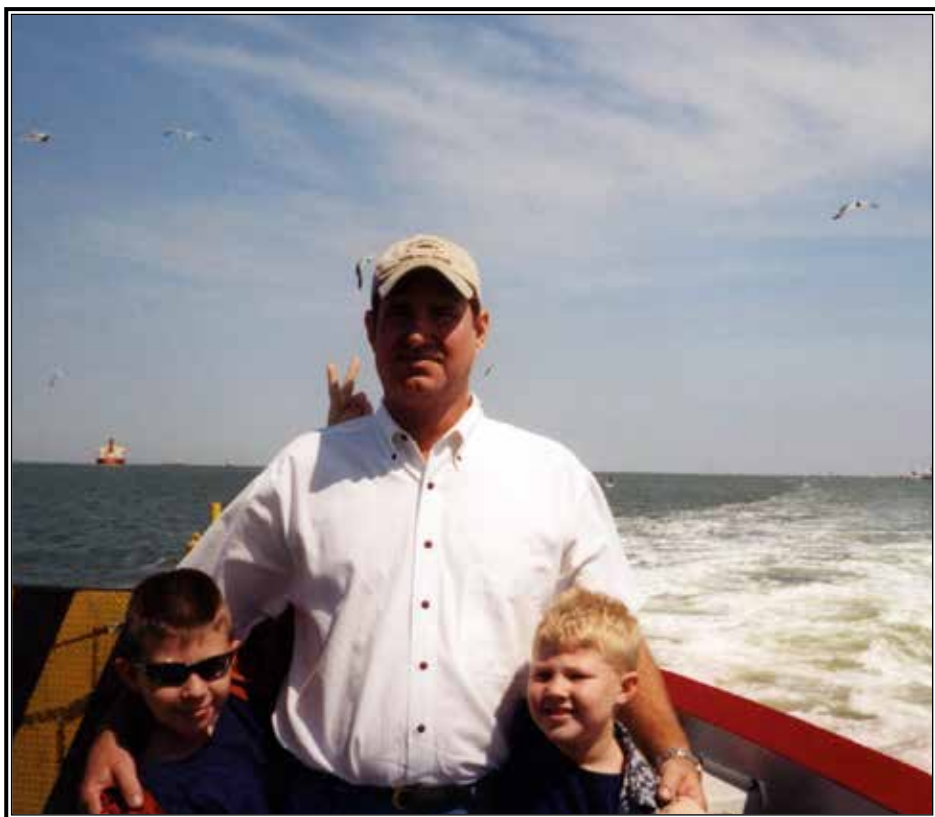
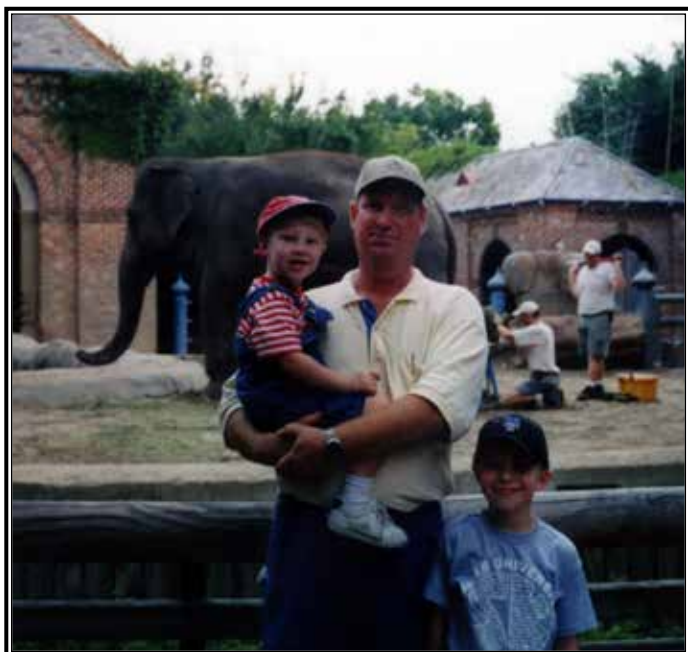
