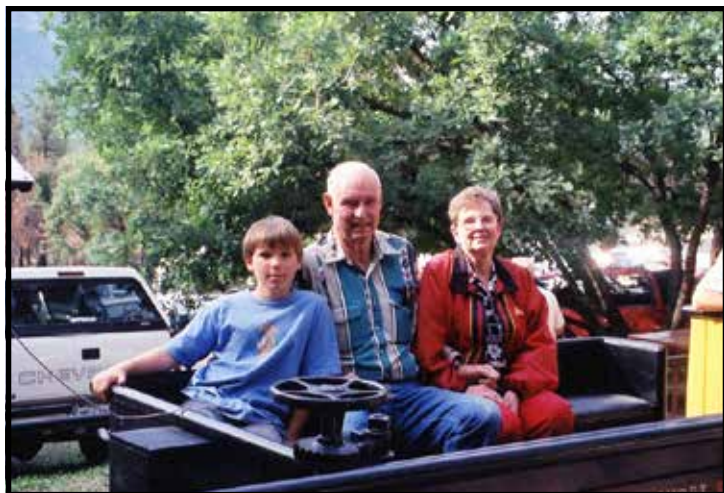














The Twenty-Third Psalm
