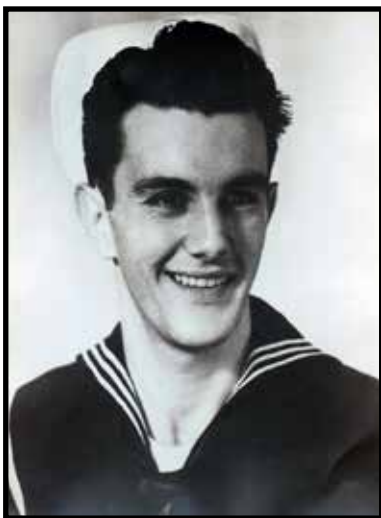

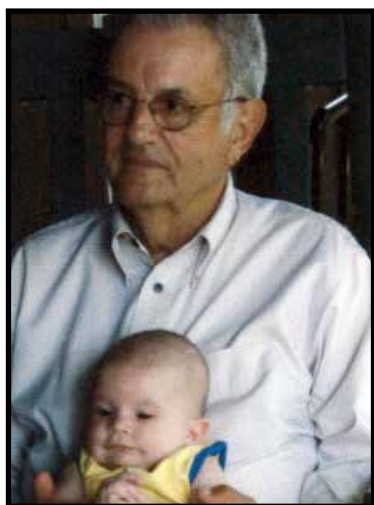

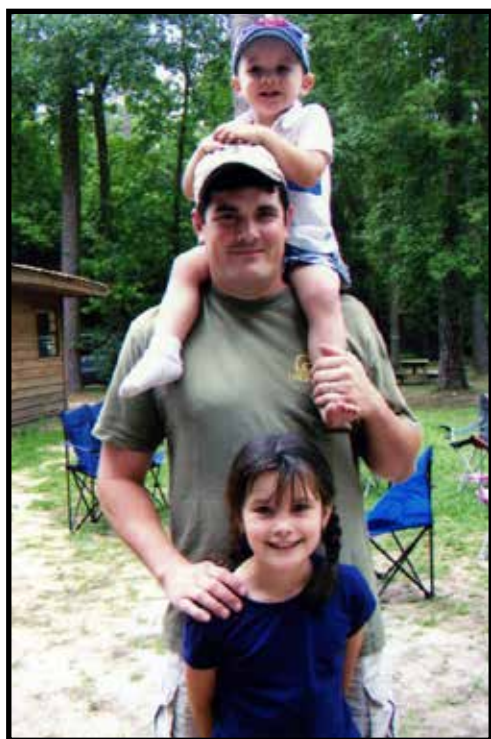
He is preceded in death by his wife, Billie Wych Monceaux.
