He was preceded in death by his parents; and brother, Alfred Moore.



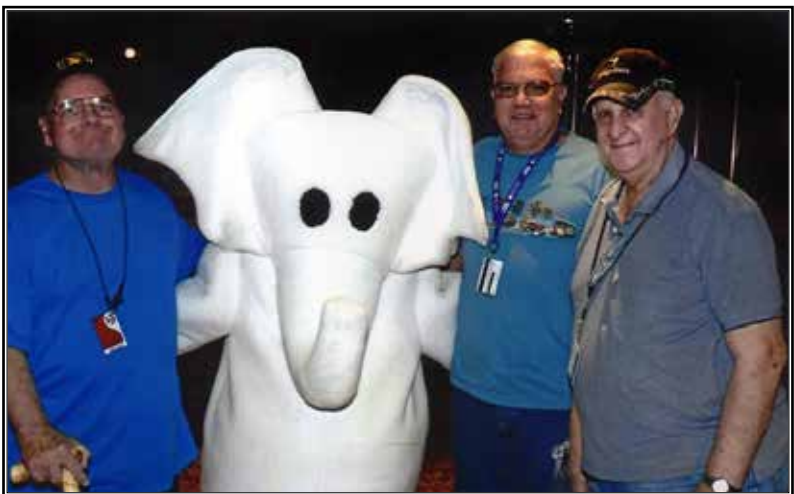
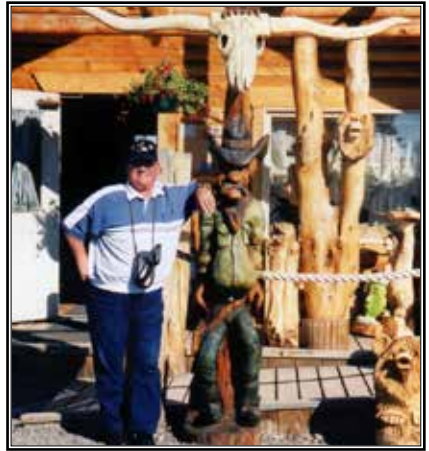








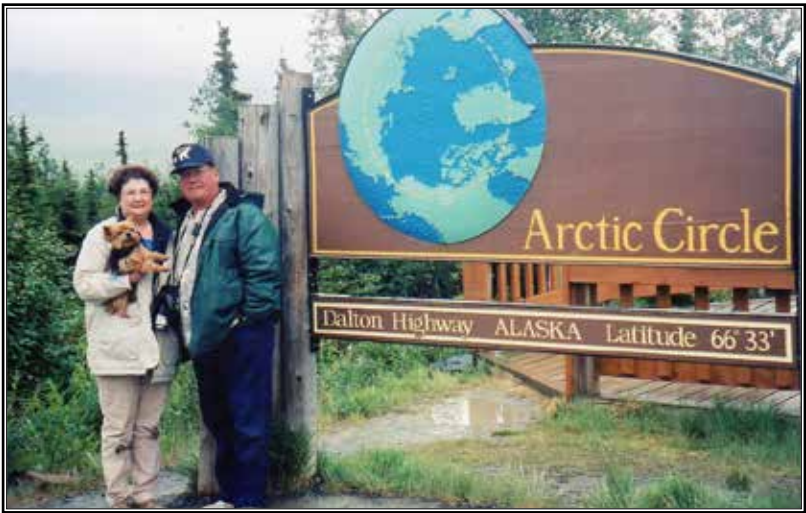






### *The Twenty-Third Psalm*
