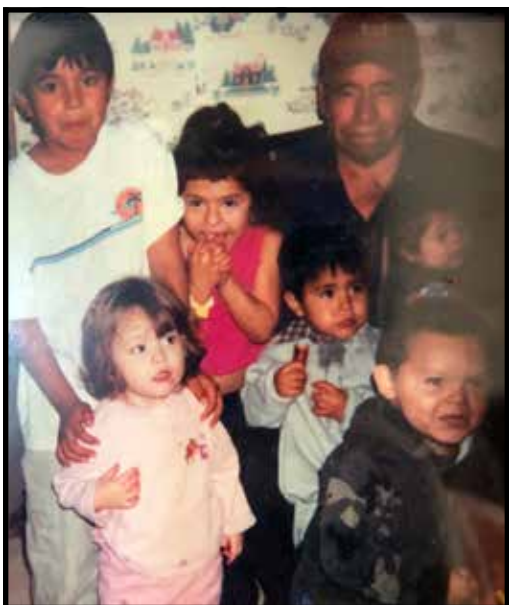
He is preceded in death by his parents; and grandson, Jose Alberto Anaya.
