

She married Wallace "Wally" Neumann on September 30, 1950, just after her eighteenth birthday. Their first home was a basement apartment



She held various jobs as bank teller in the locations they were living, until she took a position as bookkeeper at Clear Creek High School in League City, Texas. Kathryn is preceded in death by her parents; husband of sixty-three years, Wallace Roger Neumann; two brothers; and three sisters.






























