She is preceded in death by her parents; sister, Patty Gordy; and brother-in-law, KC Gordy.











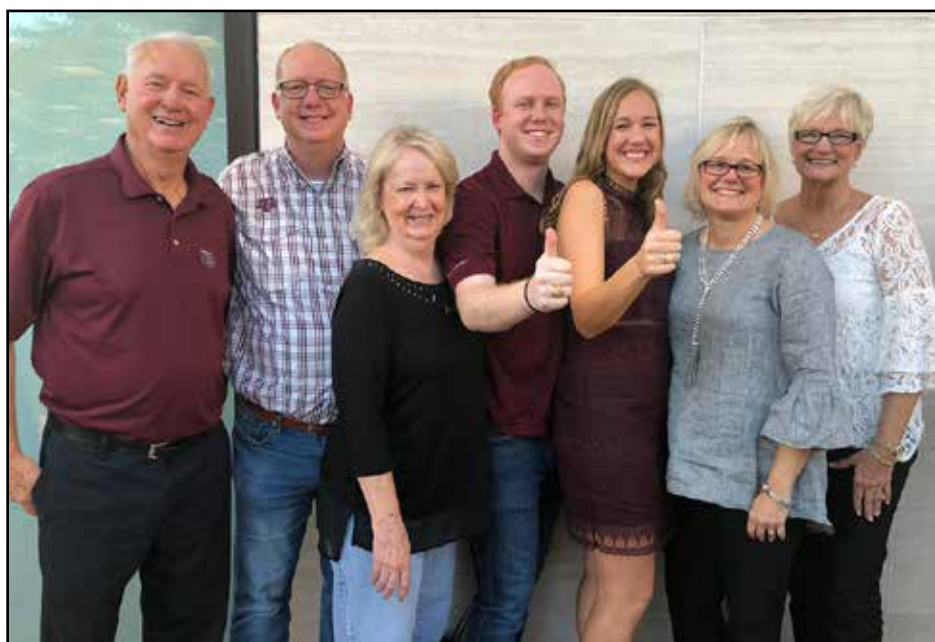
