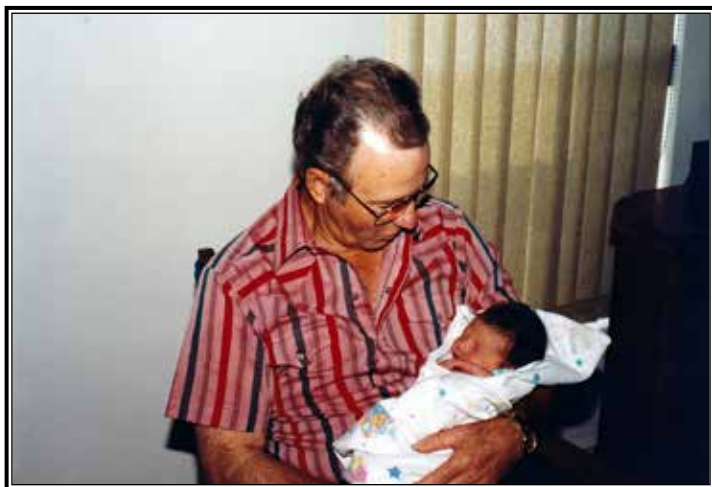
Jack Preston Norsworthy, 86, of Beaumont, died Sunday, June 10, 2018. He was born on September 8, 1931, to Gertrude Bevil Norsworthy and Charles Norsworthy, who served in World War I, in Kirbyville. He was a United States Army veteran having served in the Korean War. Jack was a dedicated Christian. 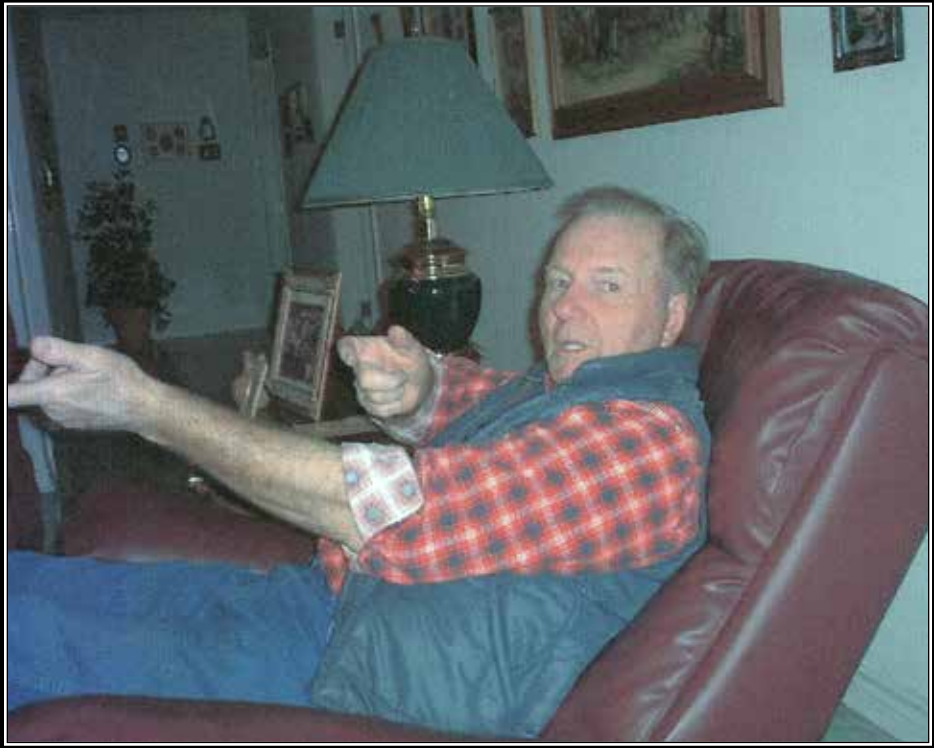
