He is preceded in death by his parents; son, Ronnie O'Day; brother, Mike O'Day; and sister, Janie O'Day.







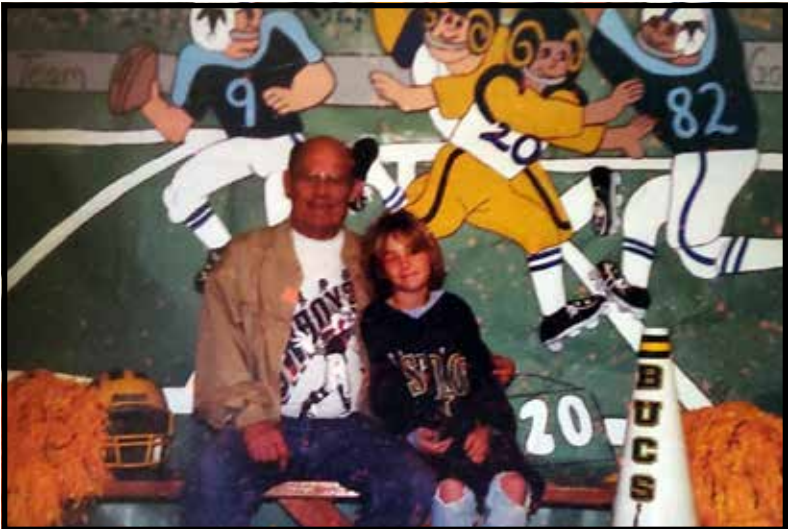
