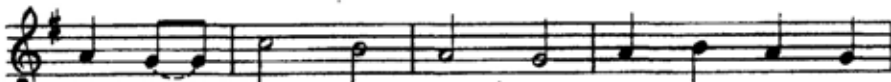

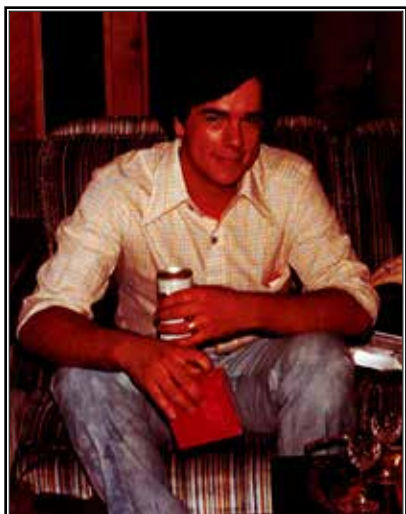
She is preceded in death by her parents; husband, Paul Thomas O’Neill; and son, Paul Thomas O’Neill, Jr.

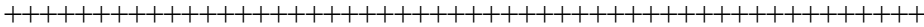




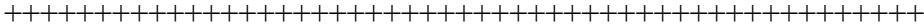
