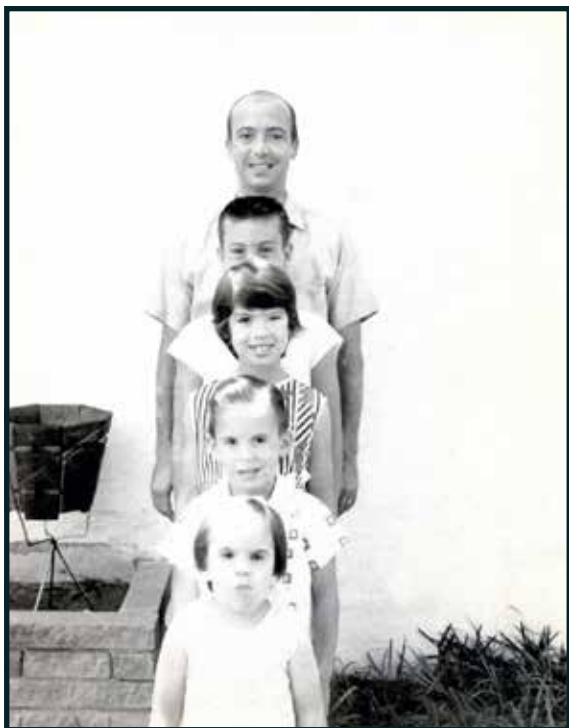

She is preceded in death by her husband, Jerry Dale O'Shea; her parents; five brothers; and three sisters.





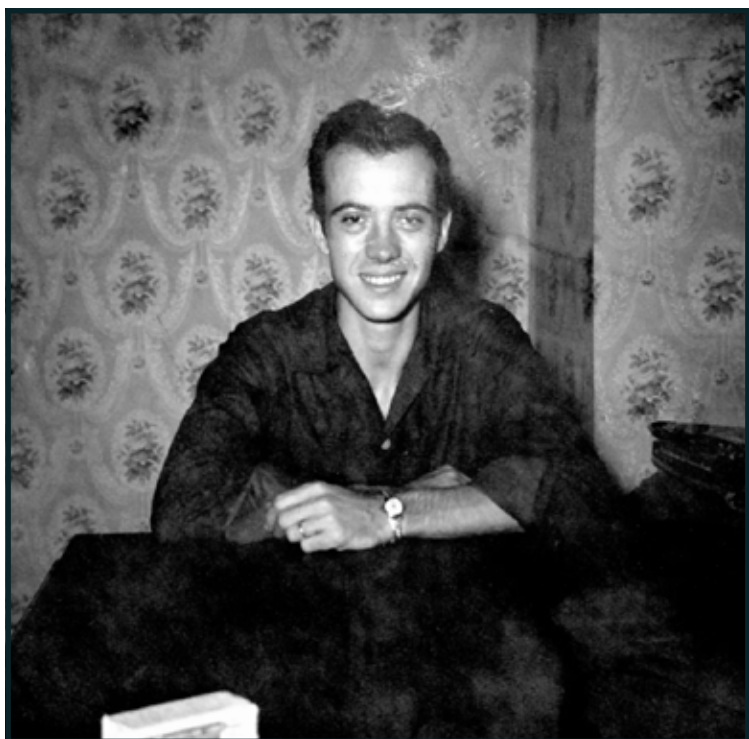
