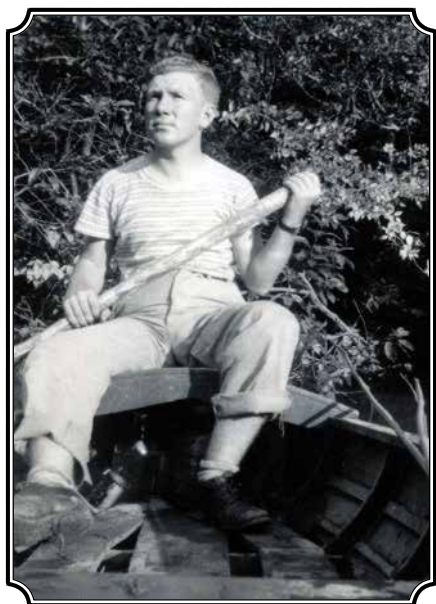

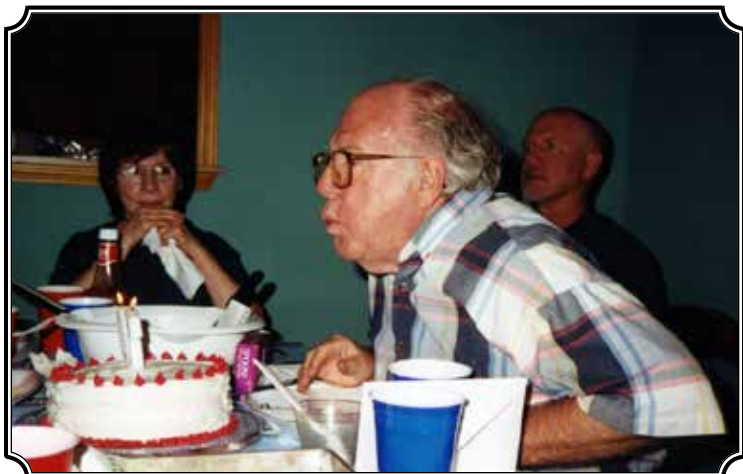
He is preceded in death by his parents, Annie and William Page; and sisters, Francis Page and Dona Page Blaschke.

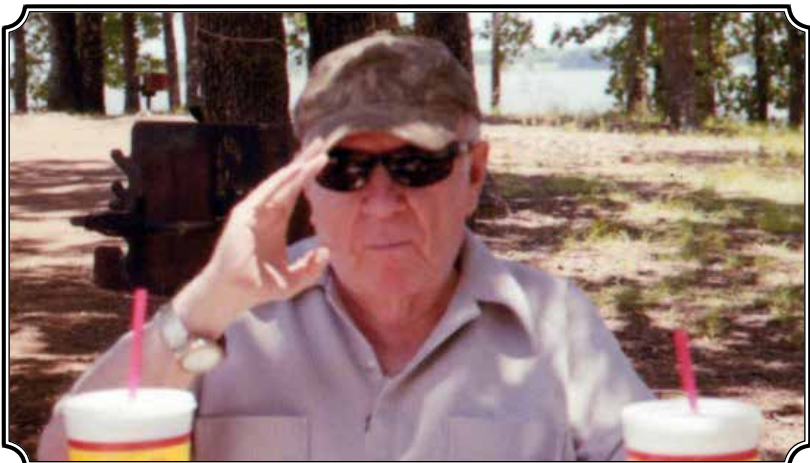


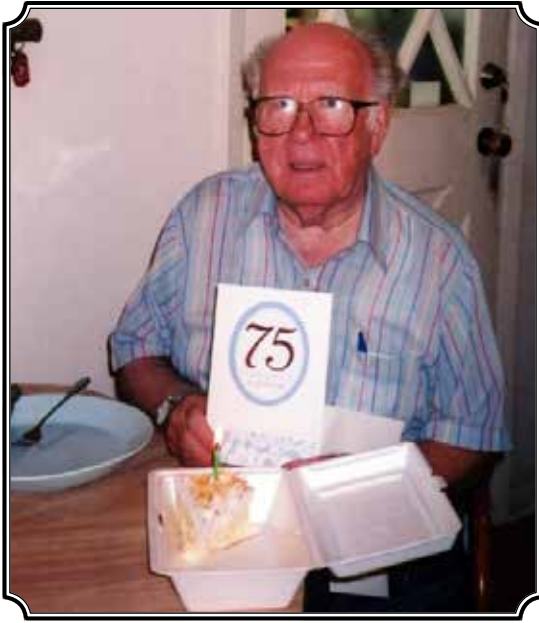
