She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Sam Lucas Papania; daughter, Kristi Gaye Papania Menefree; two brothers; and one sister.



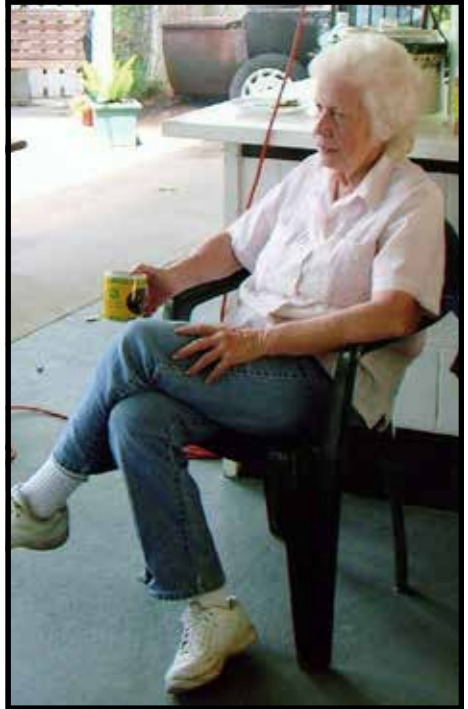
