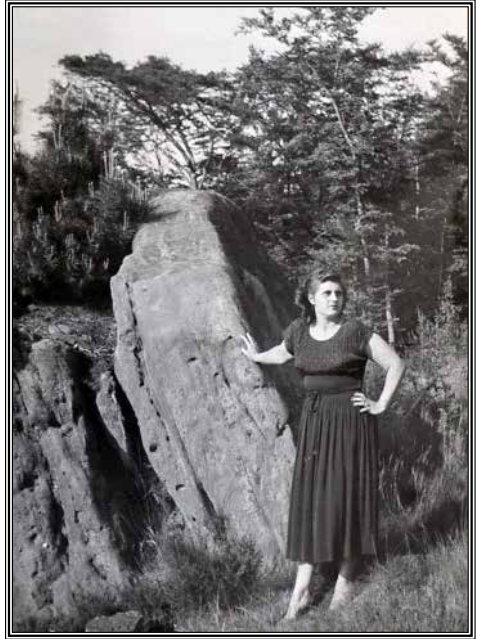
She was preceded in death by her parents and husband, Howard Phillips.









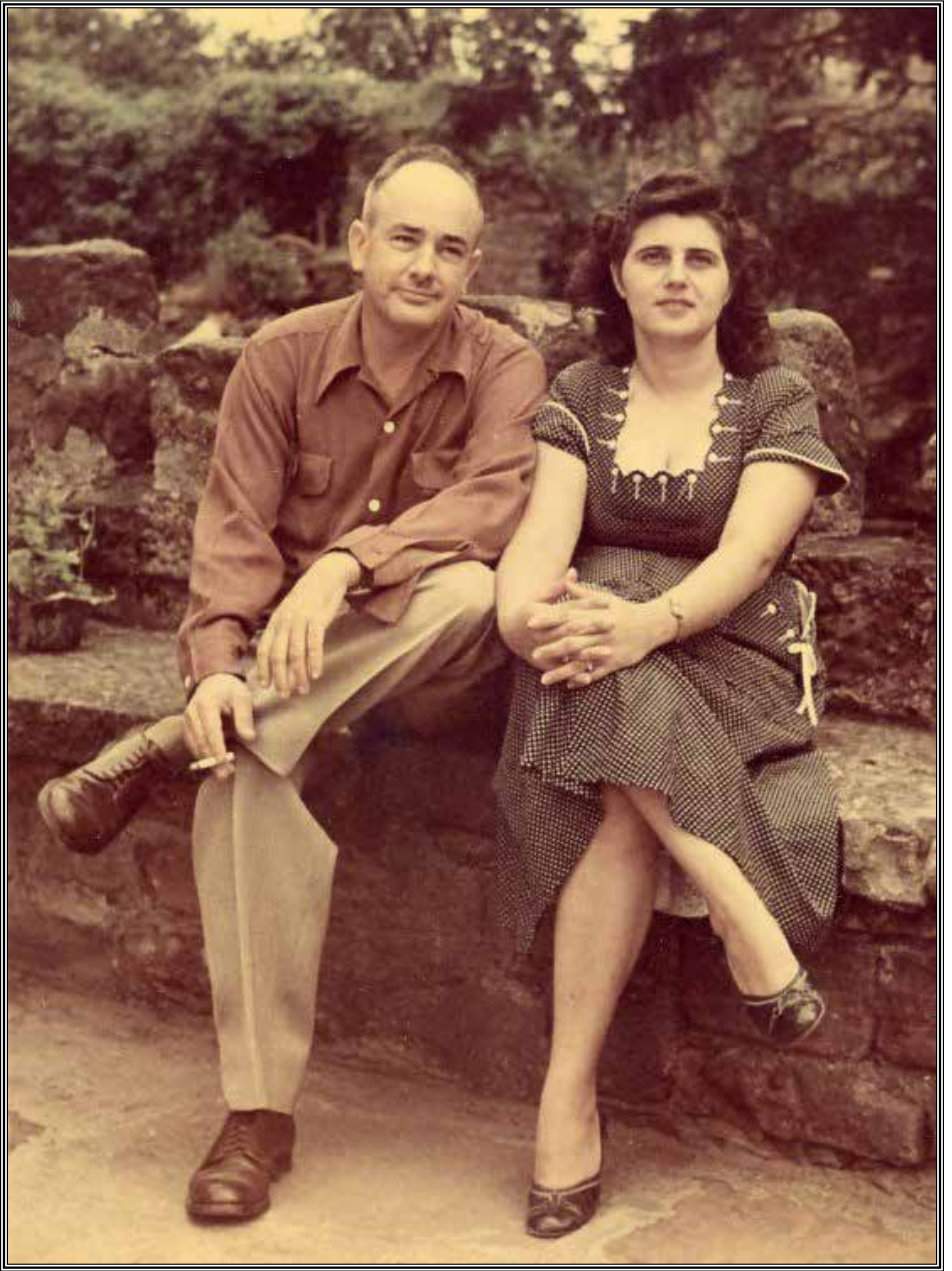


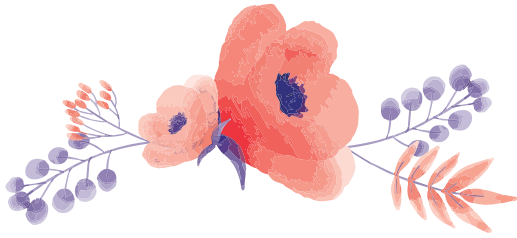

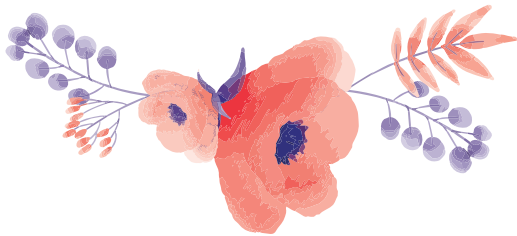
