She was born on September 21, 1924, in Marshall, to Adele Stein Kariel and Louis Kariel, Sr. Maurine graduated from Marshall High School as valedictorian. She received her Bachelor's degree, with honors in English, from the University of Texas, where she was a member of Alpha Epsilon Phi as well as Phi Betta Kappa.

Stanley was overseas when he asked Maurine to marry him and deputized her brother, Louis, to put the ring on her finger. After marrying, Maurine

and Stanley moved to Beaumont in 1949, when he joined Orgain Bell and Tucker. Her community involvement centered on Temple Emanuel.
