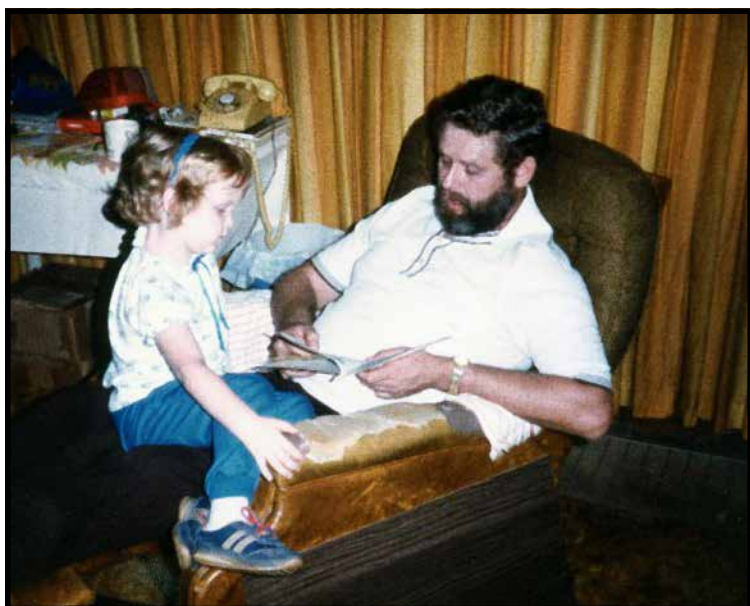

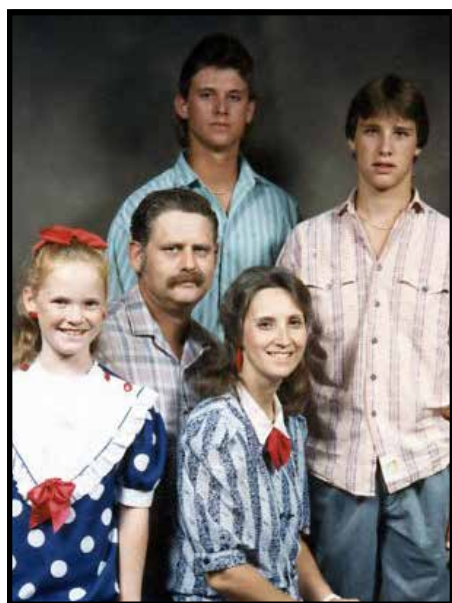

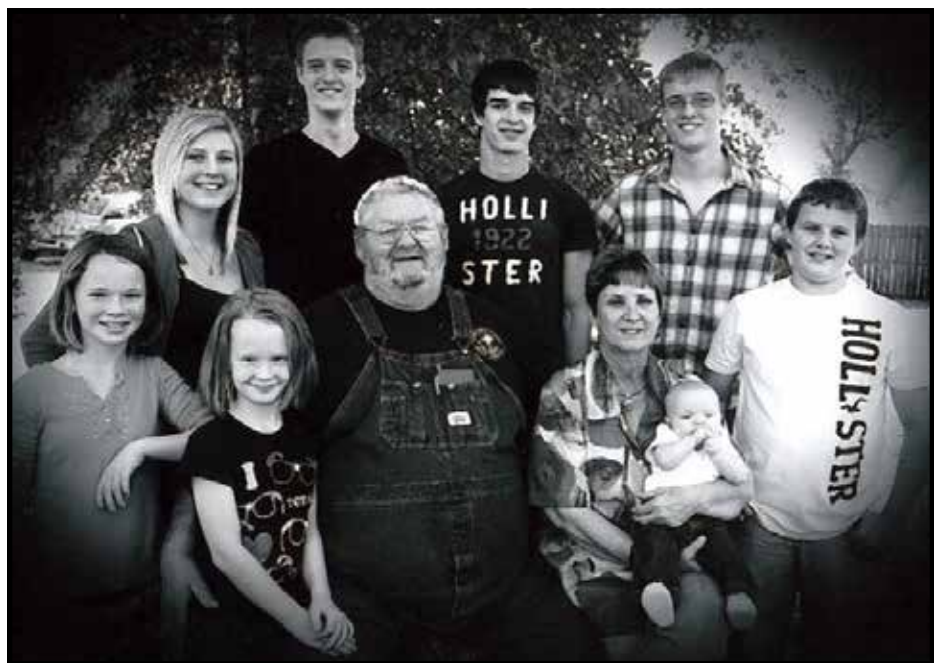

“The Army Goes Rolling Along”

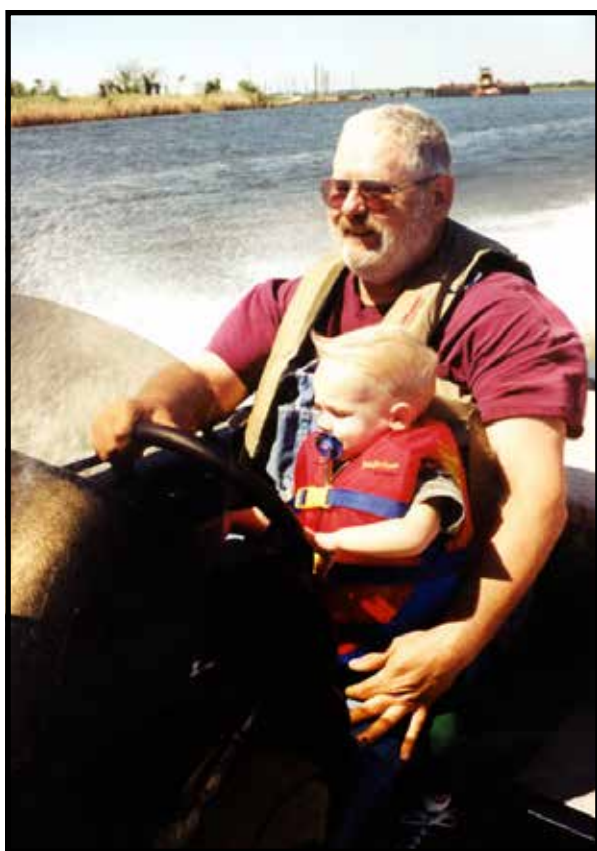
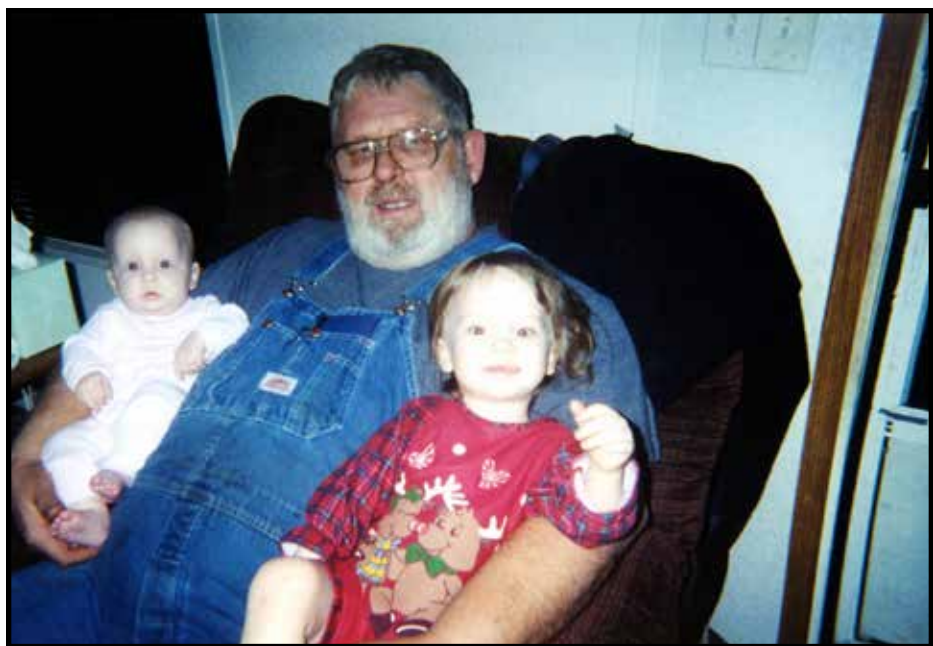
March along, sing our song, with the Army of the free,

That The Army Goes Rolling Along.

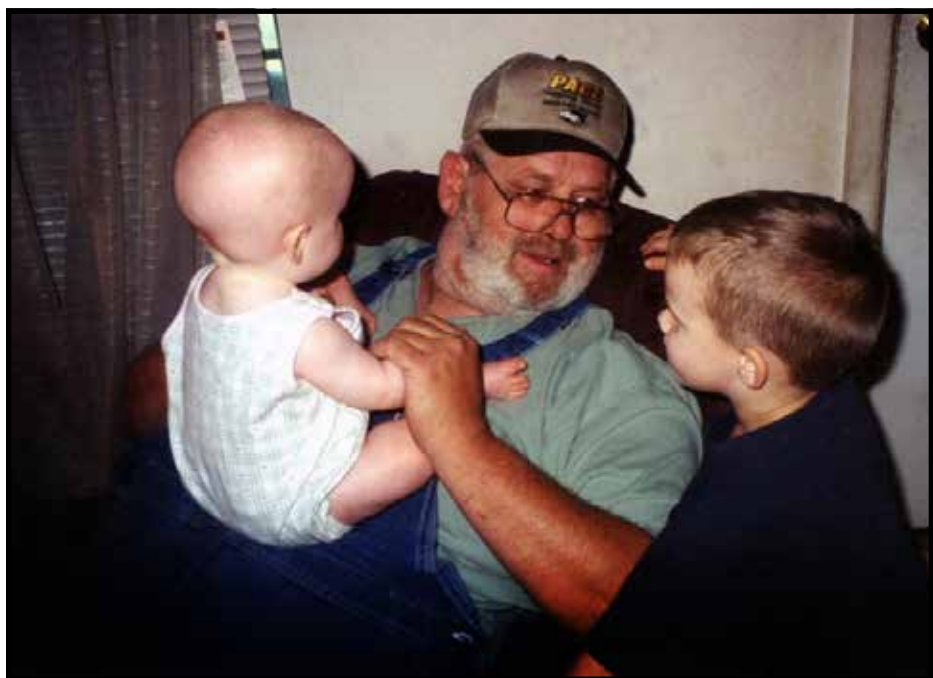
Verse: Valley Forge, Custer's ranks,
