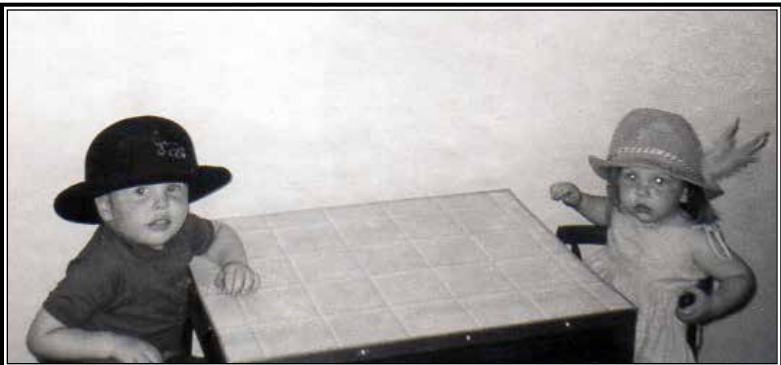

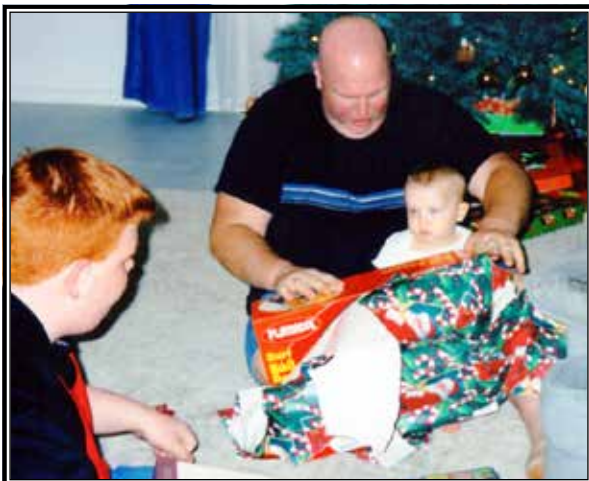












## *The Twenty-Third Psalm*
