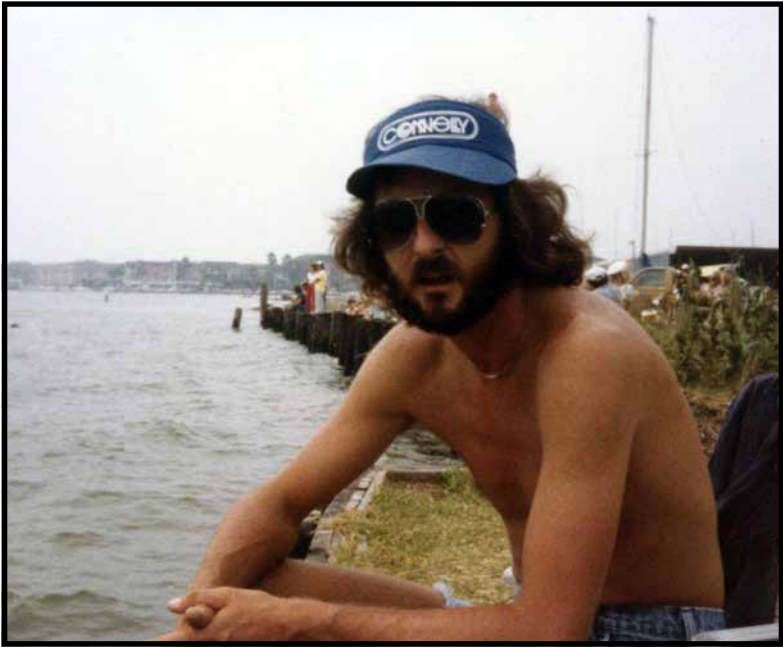

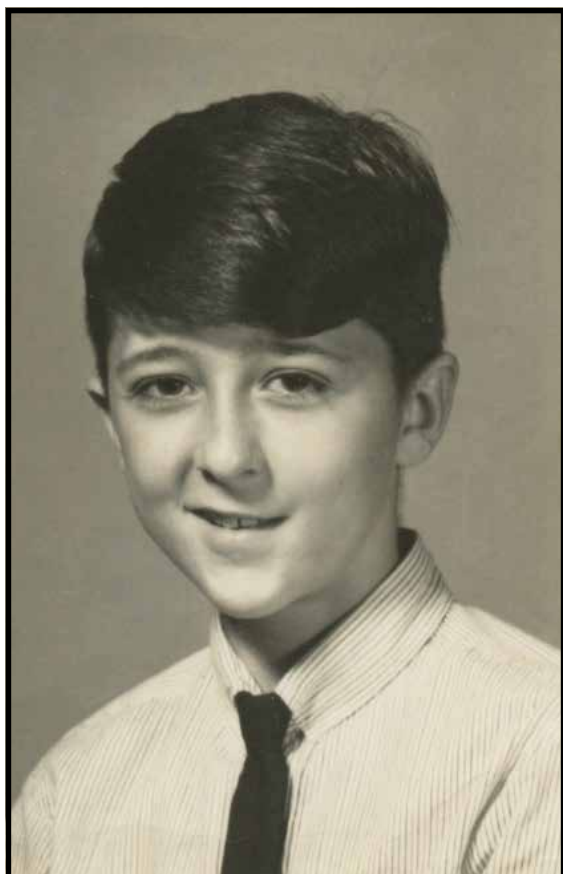

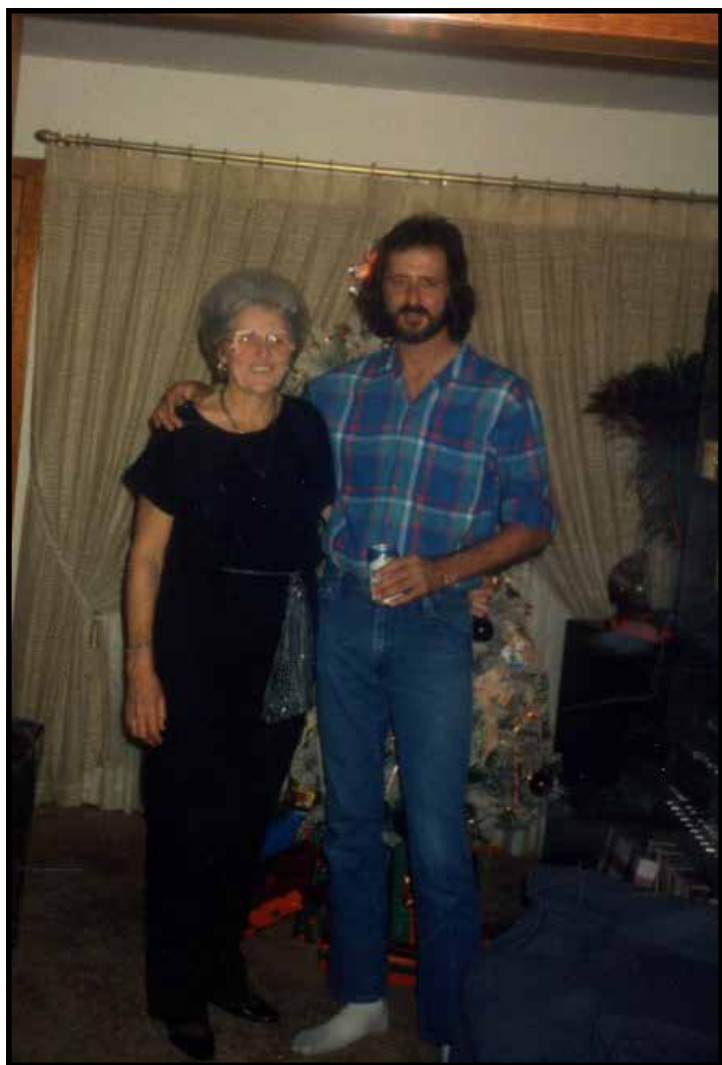
His favorite pastime was playing basketball in the pool with his boys.

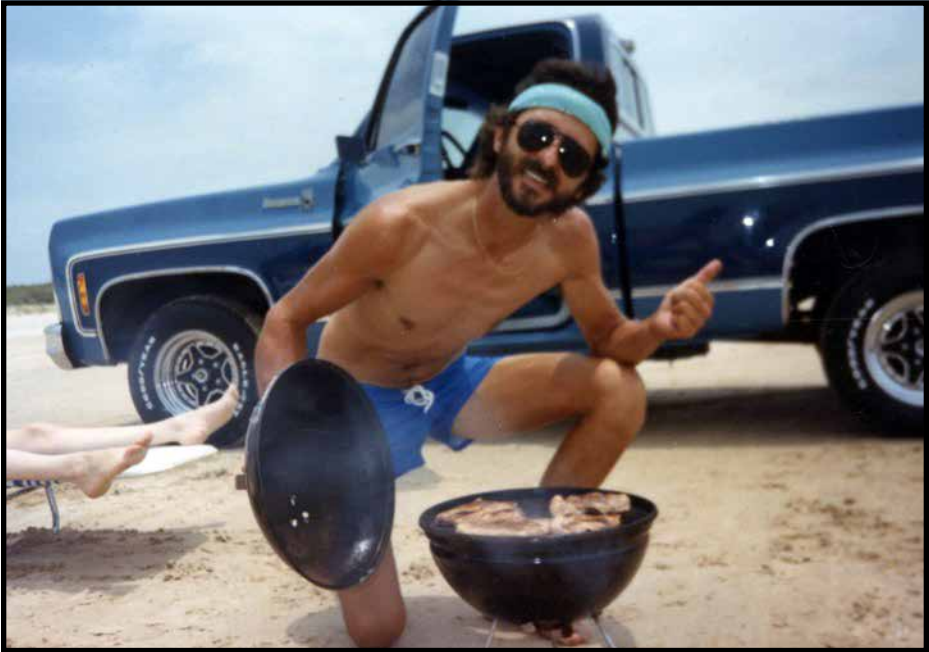
