



























## THE MASTER'S BOUQUET

The Master walked in His garden, Plucking flowers along the way; He plucked one of my loved ones, To add to his bouquet.


My heart at first was broken,

My Lord has a need for just this one, For the pattern He has in mind; But it's hard for the rest of us to see Why we must be left behind.


Perhaps we are not ready to go just yet
