July 15, 1926 - June 13, 2019



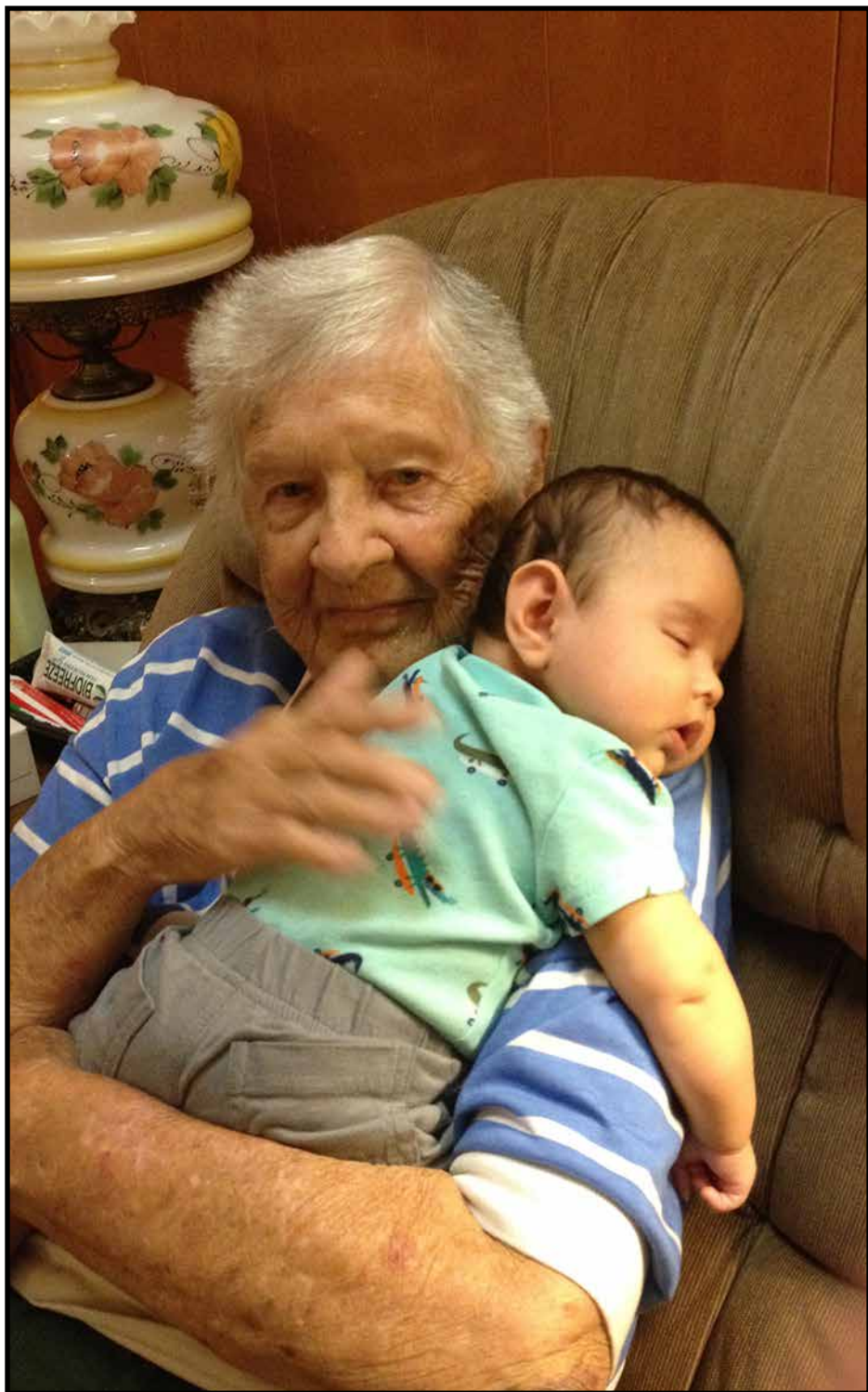
