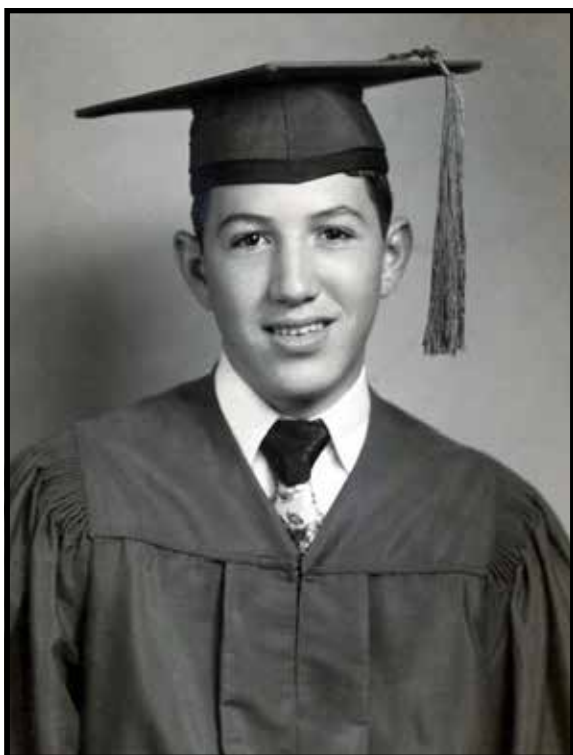
Gene graduated from Nederland High School and later from Lamar University. He served

He was preceded in death by his parents.



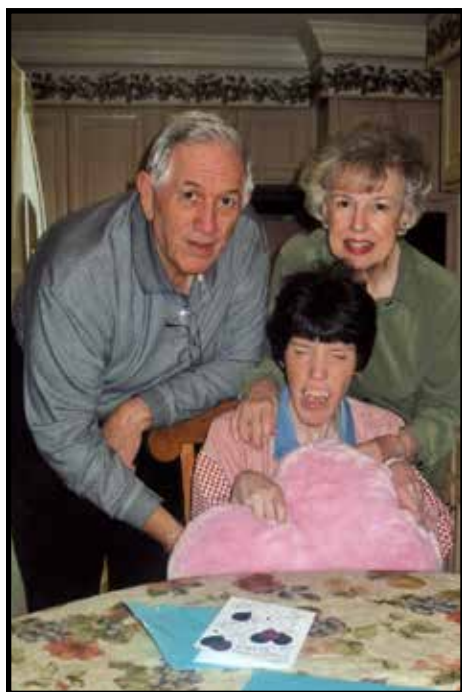
