The family would like to thank her caregivers at Holland Place, Forever Young, and New Century Hospice.





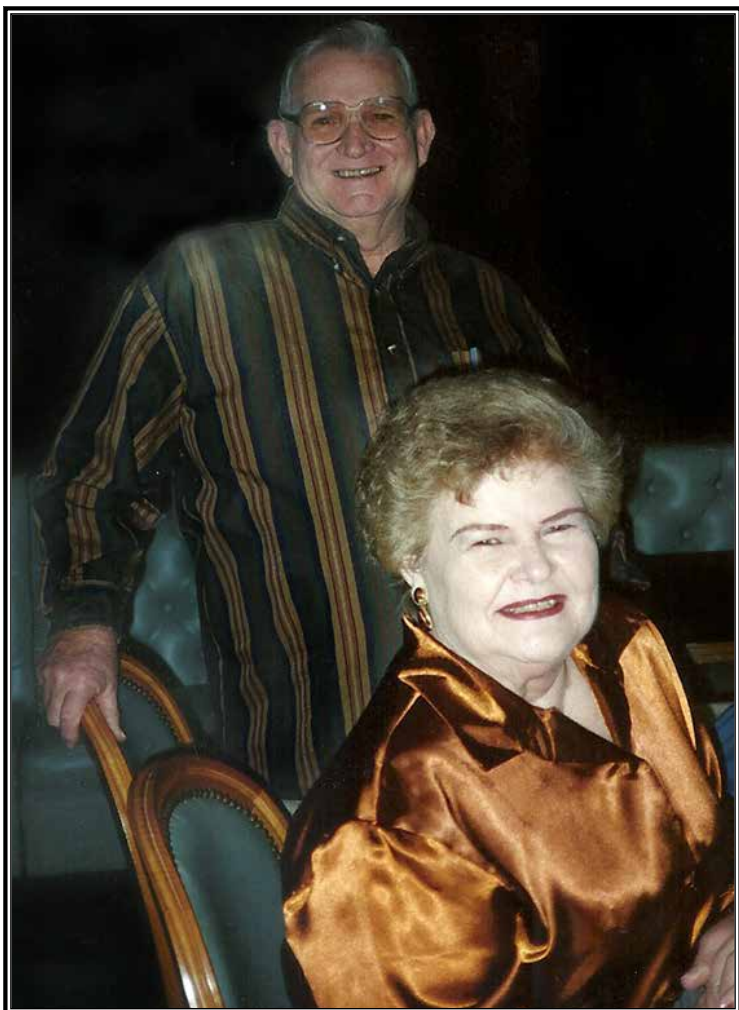
