of Austin; and sister, Jerrilee Meeker, of Austin.

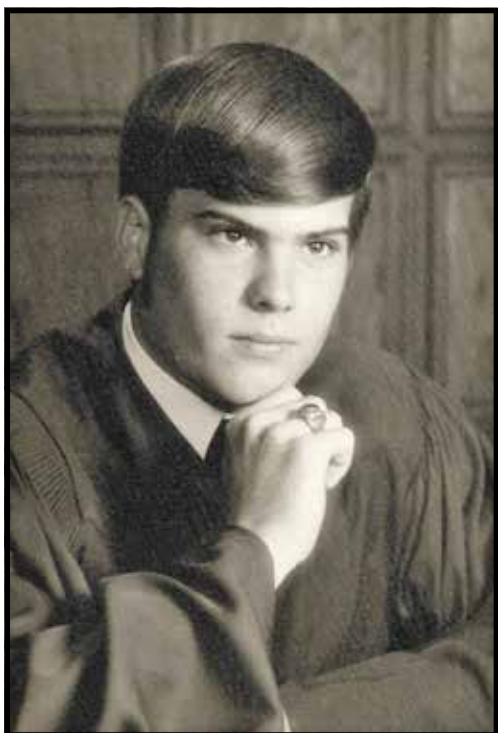
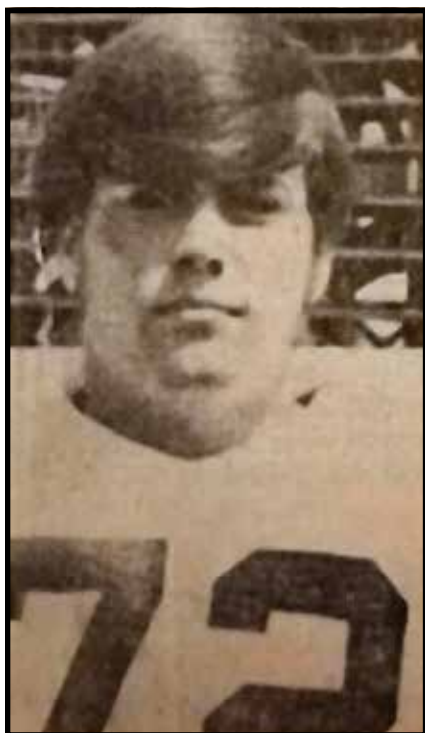
He is preceded in death by his father, Gerald Snyder.

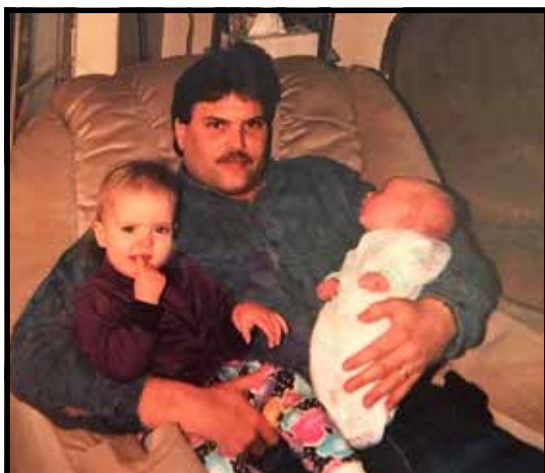
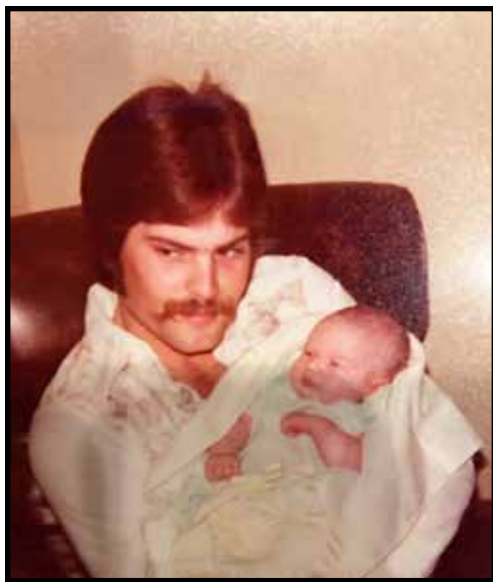


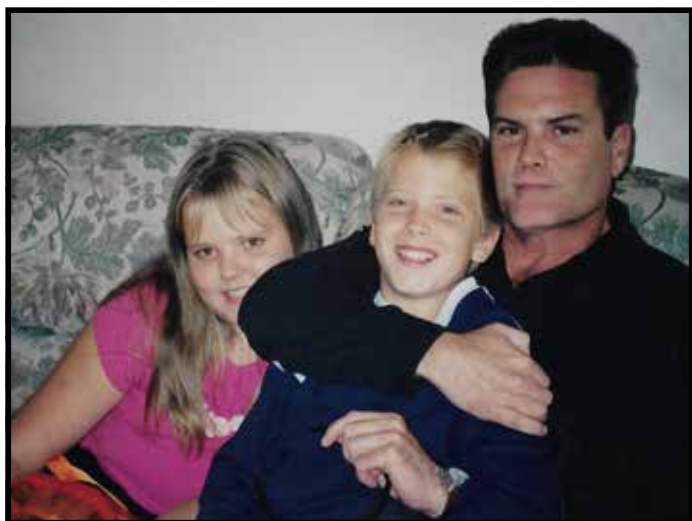
