She is preceded in death by the love of her life for sixty-nine years, Chester Sole and sister-in-law, Jackie Taylor.







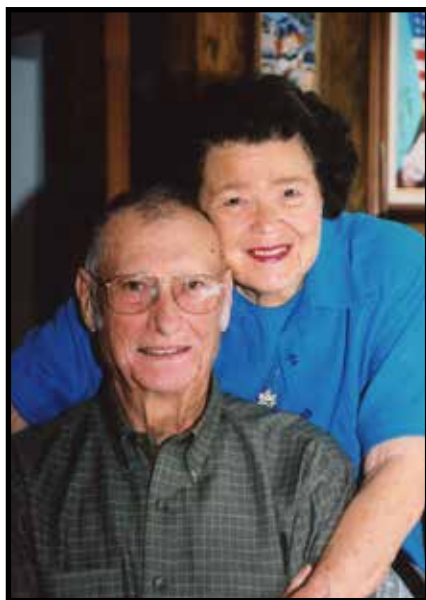
